Coach Rick Bishop - USA-Swimming

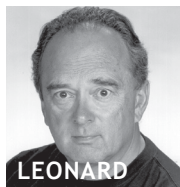
Rick Bishop has been with USA Swimming since 2008 first as a Sport Performance Consultant for the Club Development Division and currently with the National Team Division. Rick came to USA Swimming from Jacksonville, Florida where he was the head coach of the Bolles School and Bolles Sharks club team. During his accomplished 20-year coaching career, he experienced success with the Memphis Tiger Swimming, Clearwater Aquatic Team, and Baylor Swim Club. Rick's teams have won state high school titles in both Tennessee and Florida. His 2007 Bolles Sharks team finished second in combined scoring at the USA Swimming Spring Nationals. Bishop has also coached international teams at the Pan American Games, World Championships as well as the Olympics.

Coach John Leonard - American Swimming Coaches Association

Wrote and teaches the ASCA Level 2 Stroke School and works daily on creating new teaching methods for young age group swimmers. John is an active coach with his age group team, SwimFast, in south Florida.

Coach Ray Looze - Indiana University

Ray Looze is currently the Head Coach at Indiana University, where he has been leading the men's team since the 2002-03 season and the women's team since 2005-06. During his time at IU he has overseen the development of several notable Hoosier backstrokers, including: Leila Vaziri (2007 World Champion in 50 back in World Record time), Ben Hesen (2008 NCAA Champion in the 100 back), Kate Fesenko (2010 NCAA Champion in the 200 back), and Eric Ress (2011 NCAA 2nd place finisher in the 100 and 200 backs, and BigTen Swimmer of the Year). He guided the Indiana men to the 2006 BigTen title, their first since 1985, and the Indiana women to BigTen titles in 2007, 2009, 2010 and 2011. Prior to coaching at IU, Looze was the head coach at the University of the Pacific from 1997-2002, and the head coach at New Jersey's Peddie School, where the team won the 1994-95 mythical high school national championship.
