Entry Limit: Swimmers may swim four (4) individual events and 3 relays per day. Total number of

entries will be limited to 1200 swims. Deck seeding will be allowed at the discretion

on the Meet Director.

Entry deadline: The Entry Chair must receive completed entry form, waiver, and fees **no later that**

Monday, February 2, 2004. No phone entries will be accepted. This meet is being run with Hy-Tek software. Teams wishing to submit their entries via disk or e-mail are encouraged to do so. If submitting by e-mail bring money owed and waiver to the meet. No seed times will be changed once the entry chair has seeded the meet.

Fees: Entry fees are \$2.00 for individual events, \$8.00 for relays, and a \$1.25 splash fee per

swimmer. Entry fees must accompany entry forms. Make checks payable to: Beloit

Aquatic Team. Fees are non-refundable.

Break: There will be a 30 minute break after the IM's at the discretion of the meet director.

Event Staging: This is a pre-seeded meet. Swimmers should report to behind the blocks prior to the

start of the event. Help will be available to put the swimmers in the correct lane and

heat.

Adaptive Swimmers: If you have any swimmers with special needs, please notify the Meet Director no later

than Wednesday, February 2, 2004.

Awards: Individual and Relay event ribbons will be given for 1-6 place. Heat winner ribbons

will be given in all individual events. Individual high point awards (1st place) will be given in each gender and age group division based upon scoring in the individual

events.

Scoring: Individual events: 7-5-4-3-2-1

Final Results: One copy of the final results will be sent to each team represented.

Concessions: Food and Beverages will be available.

Conduct: Each team is responsible for the conduct of its' swimmers.

Directions: From I-90, South Beloit exit:

Drive west to the second stoplight (at the intersection with Park Avenue), passing by the Holiday Inn and the antiques mall. Turn right onto Park Avenue, and drive north through two stoplights, continuing up the hill until you reach Emerson Street. Turn left (west) on Emerson Street, and the fieldhouse/pool will be approximately three blocks

ahead on the right

From I-43/Hwy 81 exit off I-90:

I-43 ends and becomes Milwaukee Road. Follow into Beloit (due west, past Walmart and Staples), cross the railroad tracks, and veer left (at the "Y" in the road) to remain on Milwaukee Road. Follow (southwest) to Emerson Street, where you turn right. The

Fieldhouse/pool is about seven blocks ahead.

Coming in Hwy. 81 from west:

Follow Hwy. 81 signs across the Rock River. Make first turn to the right (south) on Pleasant Street. Turn left (east) on Emerson Street and the fieldhouse/pool are directly

on left.
