- Location:** Tremper High School

- Facility:** Tremper is an indoor, six lane, twenty-five yard pool with two non-turbulent lane lines per lane, backstroke flags and a thirty-inch block height. The depth is ten feet at the starting end, sloping up to three feet six inches. A fully automated Daktronics timing system with touch pads, backup button, six-lane scoreboard and two manual watches will be used. This meet will be fully computerized.
- Eligibility:** All swimmers must be registered with USS and their USS numbers must appear on the entry form. Out of state entrants must bring their USS cards and be prepared to show them to the Clerk of Course. Age as of Friday, November 15, 2002 will be used. Coaches must present a current coaching card before receiving packet!
- Entry Limits:** All swimmers may enter a total of four (4) individual events plus relays each day of the meet, except Friday, which is limited to two (2) individual events.
- Deck Entries/
Registration:** Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the meet director, and must be accompanied by a payment of \$3.00 per individual event, \$9.00 per relay. Deck Registration will be allowed if accompanied by a check for \$48.00 payable to Wisconsin Swimming, Inc.
- Final Results:** All teams will receive final results within two weeks of the completion of the meet. Any extra copies that may be required can be ordered at the admissions table for \$7.00.
- Officials:** Bruce Metzler, Bob Staskewich and others to be determined later.
- Timing:** All events will be timed finals. Please submit correct YARD seed times.
- Entry Fees:** \$2.50 per individual event and \$8.00 per relay plus \$1.25 Splash Fee per swimmer.
- Reservations:** Reservations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis determined by the postmark (not before September 10, 2002 for Wisconsin teams and September 18, 2001 for out of state teams).
- Deadline:** Reservation checks will be accepted for individual events. Entries, Recap of Entries and Waiver forms for the meet must be received by **Monday, October 28, 2002** if submitted on paper, or **Monday, November 4, 2002** if submitted on diskette. Late entries will not be accepted. *Please note*, money used for reservations is *not refundable* and cannot be used to offset relay fees. Submit entries to: **Tom DeVroy 1456-40th Ct. - Entry Forms:** This meet is computerized. **Do not submit entry cards.** The host club will provide all cards. All entries must be submitted either on the enclosed entry form or on a Hytek Team Manager diskette. Please name the meet MM110901. The sanctioned meet events can be downloaded from the Wisconsin Swimming website at: www.wisconsinswimming.org. The enclosed Recap of Entries Statement must be completed and the Waiver form signed. These must be returned together with the entry forms (diskette) and your check. Please submit the originals and save the copies for your records. In order to insure accurate times and names, please PRINT clearly.
- Awards:** Awards will be given for all age groups, 8 & Under through Senior. Each class, A, BB, B-C will receive ribbons for placement of 1-6. 8 & Under and Senior will be awarded as one class, with 8 & U receiving ribbons for 1-12, Seniors 1-3. Relay ribbons will be awarded to places of 1-3 for all age groups. Heat winner awards will be given for 12 & U age groups and achiever awards for 14 & U.
- Admission:** Admission charge for spectators will be \$2.00 for anyone 12 and over. Heat sheets will be available for \$2.00 per session. Friday night admission and heat sheet is \$2.00.

- Concessions:** Our concession stand will feature a wide selection of food and beverages. We will also be providing a great selection of food on Friday night. Hot coffee and fresh donuts will be for sale upon morning arrival. However, food will not be allowed in the balcony or on the deck. Swim apparel will also be available.
- Conduct:** All teams will be responsible for the conduct of their own swimmers. The meet marshals and meet director shall have the authority to disqualify swimmers for misconduct. **Smoking is not permitted on school grounds!** This rule will be strictly enforced.
- Hospitality:** There will be a hospitality room available to the coaches and officials on the second floor. All meals and refreshments will be provided to those working at this meet.
- Adaptive Swimmer:** Please notify the meet director if you have any special needs for an adaptive swimmer.
- Times:** FRIDAY: General warm-up 4:30-5:30 p.m. Meet starts at 5:40 p.m.
SATURDAY: General warm-up 7:00 - 8:00 a.m. The afternoon warm-up will start as soon as the morning session has been completed and will last one hour.
SUNDAY: General warm-up 7:00 - 8:00 a.m. The afternoon warm-up will start as soon as the morning session has been completed and will last one hour. The meet director will notify each club as to the approximate time for all sessions once meet entries have been received. Information may also be found on our website www.acronet.net/~barracuda.
- Warm-ups:** Warm up schedule.
First half hour: Circle swimming in all lanes. Swimmers must enter feet first! No diving from the blocks.
Second half hour: Lanes three and four, ONE WAY SPRINTS. Swimmers must exit from the opposite end of the pool. Starts from the blocks are permitted. More sprint lanes will be added as needed. All other lanes are circle swimming only.
- Seeding:** The meet will be pre-seeded except for Friday events 7 & 8, which require positive check-in. EVENTS 1-8 WILL BE LIMITED TO THE TOP 24 TIMES. The number of entries and time restrictions will determine limits. The events will be scheduled so that all swims will be done by approximately 9:00 p.m., and if time permits, additional swims will be added.

REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR SWIMMERS WHO DO NOT GET TO SWIM FRIDAY.
