FACILITY: Indoor, twenty five (25) yard pool with 10 lanes with nontuburlant lane lines.

Pool depth at both ends seven (7) feet. An additional 6 lanes for warm-ups and cool down will be available throughout the entire meet. The block height is 30

inches.

TIMING SYSTEM: A fully automatic timing system will be used with a manual backup button

plus 2 backup timers for each lane. A horn start will be used to start all events,

should the automatic system fail, a backup starting device will be used.

ELIGIBILITY: All swimmers must be currently registered with United States Swimming and

their USS numbers must appear on the entry form. Out of state entrants must bring their USS cards and be prepared to show them to Clerk of Course. Age as of Friday, November 7, 2003 will be used. Coaches must present a current

coaching card before receiving packet.

ENTRY LIMITS: All swimmers may enter a total of five (5) individual events plus relays each

day of the meet, except Friday, which is limited to two (2) individual events.

DECK ENTRIES/ REGISTRATION Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the meet director, and must

be accompanied by a payment of \$3.25 per individual event, \$10.00 per relay. Deck registration will be allowed if accompanied by a check for \$48.00

payable to Wisconsin Swimming, Inc.

FINAL RESULTS: All teams will receive final results within two weeks of the completion of the

meet. Any extra copies that may be required can be ordered at the admissions

table for \$7.00.

OFFICIALS: To be determined.

TIMING: All events will be timed finals. Please submit correct YARD seed times.

ENTRY FEES: \$3.25 per individual event and \$10.00 per relay plus \$1.25 Splash Fee per

swimmer.

RESERVATION: Reservations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis determined by

the postmark (not before September 9, 2003 for Wisconsin teams and

September 16, 2003 for out of state teams.)

DEADLINE: Reservation checks will be accepted for individual events. Entries, Recap of

Entries and Waiver forms for the meet must be received by 10/22/2003 if

submitted on paper or by 10/29/2003 if submitted on diskette. Late entries will not be accepted. Please note, money used for reservations is nonrefundable and cannot be used to offset relay, deck seeding fees or splash fees. Submit

Please submit the originals and save the copies for your records. In order to insure accurate times and names, please PRINT clearly.

AWARDS:

Each class, A-BB-B-C, will receive ribbons for placement 1-6 for 10 & under, 11-12, 13-14. 8 and under will be awarded as one class for placement 1-12. Seniors will be awarded as one class for placement 1-3. Relay ribbons will be awarded to places 1-3 for all age groups. Heat winner awards will be given for 12 & Under age groups and achiever awards for 14 and under.

ADMISSIONS:

Admission charge for spectators will be \$3.00 for anyone 12 and over. Heat sheets will be available for \$3.00 per session. Friday night admission and heat sheet is \$3.00.

CONCESSIONS:

A concession stand will offer a wide selection of food and beverage options. Swim apparel will be available.

CONDUCT:

All teams will be responsible for the conduct of their own swimmers. The meet marshals and meet director shall have the authority to disqualify swimmers for misconduct.

DISABLED ATHLETES: Please indicate on the entry form any special needs for those athletes requiring

them.

SEEDING: The meet will be pre-seeded except for Friday events 7 and 8, which require

positive check-in. Events 1-8 WILL BE LIMITED TO THE TOP 30 TIMES. The number of entries and time restriction will determine limits. The events will be scheduled so that all swims will be done by approximately 9:00 p.m.,

and if time permits, additional swims will be added.

REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR SWIMMERS WHO DO NOT GET TO SWIM FRIDAY.
