Facility: Schroeder is an 8 lane, 50 meter indoor pool with non-turbulent lane lines and

backstroke flags. The height of the blocks is 30 inches. A fully automated Colorado Timing System with touch pads and automatic backup as well as two (2) manual backup

watches for each lane will be used. This meet will be fully computerized.

Eligibility: All swimmers must be registered with USS and their USS numbers must appear on the

entry form. Out of state entrants must bring their USS cards and be prepared to show them to the Clerk of Course. Age as of Friday, June 1, 2001 will be used. Coaches

must present a current coaching card before receiving packet!

Entry Limits: All swimmers may enter a total of three (3) individual events plus relays each day of the

meet. Entries will be limited to 1600 per day and 200 on Friday.

Deck Entries/Registration: Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the meet director, and must be

accompanied by a payment of \$3.50 per event. Deck Registration will be allowed if

accompanied by a check for \$42.00 payable to Wisconsin Swimming, Inc.

Final Results: All teams will receive final results within two weeks of the completion of the meet.

Any extra copies that may be required can be ordered at the admissions table for \$5.00.

Officials: Bruce Metzler, Bob Staskewich and Pete Middlecamp.

Timing: All events will be timed finals. Please submit correct METER seed times.

Entry Fees: \$3.50 per individual event and \$8.00 per relay plus \$1.25 Splash Fee per swimmer.

Deadline: Reservation checks will be accepted for individual events. Entries, Recap of Entries

and Waiver for the meet must be received by <u>Friday</u>, <u>May 11, 2001</u> if submitted on paper, or <u>Friday</u>, <u>May 18, 2001</u> if submitted on diskette. Late entries will not be accepted. *Please note*, money used for reservations is *not refundable* and cannot be used to offset relay fees. Entry Forms: This meet is computerized. Do not submit entry cards. The host club will provide all

<u>www.wisconsinswimming.org</u>. The enclosed Recap of Entries Statement must be completed and the Waiver form signed. These must be returned together with the entry forms (diskette) and your check. Please submit the originals and save the copies for your records. In order to insure accurate times and names, please PRINT clearly.

Awards: Awards will be given for all age groups (8 & Under through Senior) for places of 1-16.

Relay ribbons will be awarded to places of 1-3 for all age groups.

Admissions: Admission charge for spectators will be \$3.00 for anyone 12 and over. Heat sheets will

be available for \$2.00 per session or \$3.00 for the day.

Concessions: Our concession stand will feature a wide selection of food and beverages. We will also

be providing a great selection of food on Friday night. Hot coffee and fresh donuts will

be for sale upon morning arrival.

Conduct: All teams will be responsible for the conduct of their own swimmers. The meet

marshals and meet director shall have the authority to disqualify swimmers for

misconduct. Smoking is not permitted on the Schroeder grounds! This rule will be

strictly enforced.

Hospitality: If available, there will be a hospitality room next to the secondary pool off the west

entrance. All meals and refreshments will be provided to the coaches and officials.

Adaptive Swimmer: Please notify the meet director if you have any special needs for an adaptive swimmer.

Times: FRIDAY: General warm-up 4:30-5:30 p.m. Meet starts at 5:40 p.m.

SATURDAY: General warm-up 8:00 - 9:00 a.m. The afternoon warm-up will start as

soon as the morning session has been completed and last 45 minutes.

SUNDAY: General warm-up 7:00 - 8:00 a.m. The afternoon warm-up will start as soon as the morning session has been completed and last 45 minutes. The meet director will notify each club as to the approximate time for all sessions once meet entries have been received. Information may also be found on our web site www.acronet.net/~barracuda.

Warm-ups: All swimmers must enter the pool <u>FEET FIRST!!!</u> Warm-up schedule applies to all

sessions. First half of warm-up - circle swim all lanes. Next half of warm-up Lanes 3-6 will be sprints, lanes 1, 2, 7 and 8 - Circle Swim. All sprints must exit opposite end of pool. Any violation or misconduct may result in a DQ of the swimmer's next individual event. Additional sprint lanes may be added as needed.

Seeding: The meet will be pre-seeded except for Friday events 7 & 8, which require positive check-in. EVENTS 1-8 WILL BE LIMITED TO THE TOP 24

TIMES. The number of entries and time restrictions will determine limits. The events will be scheduled so that all swims will be done by approximately 9:00 p.m., and if time

permits, additional swims will be added.

REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR SWIMMERS WHO DO NOT GET TO SWIM.
