Facility: 50 meter heated outdoor pool with eight 9' wide lanes, non turbulent lane

dividers, 13' depth at starting blocks, 3' 3" depth at shallow end and 27"

high starting platforms.

Eligibility: USS and/or YMCA swimmers are welcome to participate. Swimmer's age

as of July 8, 2005 shall determine age group.

Rules: USA Swimming & Wisconsin long course rules prevail for the meet. In the

200m relay, the 2nd and 4th swimmer must start in the water using hand to

hand starts. Fly over starts will be used.

Entries: Swimmers may compete in up to three (3) events per day and seven (7)

events for the entire meet plus relays.

Awards: Individual event: Medals 1st-8th Ribbons 9th-16th

Relays: Medals 1st-3rd Ribbons 4th-8th

Individual High Point: Trophies 1st-8th, Medals 9th - 16th

Awards must be picked up at the meet.

Time Schedule: Friday Afternoon General Warm-up 12:30 PM. Meet starts at 1:30 PM.

Friday Evening General Warm-up 3-4 PM Meet starts at 4 PM. Saturday and Sunday: General Warm-up 7-8 A.M. Meet starts at 8:05 AM. The afternoon warm-ups will start as soon as the morning session has been completed, with the start of the afternoon session being 60 minutes after

the start of the warm-ups.

Admission Fee: Heat sheets cost is \$5. Family admission is included with heat sheet.

Concessions: An outstanding menu of food and drink will be available at the pavillion.

Final Results: Final results will be posted in the pavilion north of the pool.

Conduct: All clubs will be responsible for the conduct of their own swimmers. The

Meet Director has the authority to disqualify swimmers found misbehaving. Coaches must display USS or YMCA credentials at all times

while on deck.

Erb Park

Park Location:

1800 North Morrison Street. Erb Park is located between Morrison and Drew Streets and between Glendale Avenue and Roosevelt Street.

Parking:

Parking is available on the street around the park and in the parking lot north of the pool. Absolutely no parking is allowed on the grass.

Hours:

The park is open from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

First Aid:

The First Aid Station is located adjacent to the pool lobby.

Spectator areas:

Spectators are only allowed on the bleacher side of the pool deck. Spectators are also welcome to watch the meet from the grassy areas on either side of the pool. Only coaches, swimmers, officials and host meet workers are allowed on the ends or office side of the pool deck.

Food and Beverages:

No food or beverages are allowed on the pool deck (accept water in plastic containers). Picnic Tables are available near the pavilion about 100 meters north of the pool. Please help us keep the pool and park area neat and clean.

Glass containers:

Glass beverage containers are prohibited within the park.

Alcoholic beverages:

No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the park.

Pets:

Animals are not allowed in the park at any time.

Tents:

Tents or other structures larger than 200 square feet require a permit from the City of Appleton. Tents must be picked up each evening before the park closes.

Amplification:

Use of amplification systems within the park must be approved by the Appleton Parks and Recreation Department.

Motor Vehicles:

No person shall drive or park any motor vehicle, motorcycle, motorbike or moped in the park except by written permission from the Director of Parks and Recreation.

Other Activities:

Families are welcome to share the park with the community. In addition to the pool, Erb Park has green space with mature trees, playground equipment, a soccer field, tennis courts, a basketball court and a volleyball court.

Prohibited activities:

The following are prohibited: Fires (except when contained in grills), archery, golf, fireworks, camping and mechanical rides.
