- DATE:** Saturday October 2, 2004
- PLACE:** HARTFORD HIGH SCHOOL 805 Cedar Street, Hartford, Wisconsin
- WARMUP:** Warm-up: 9:00-10:00 AM as follows: 9:00-9:30 circle swim all lanes NO diving. 9:30-10:00 one-way Sprints with dive lanes 3&4, push 50's 2&5, circle lanes 1&6. Failure to follow warm-up guidelines may result in disqualification from the next individual event. Meet starts at 10:05 AM.
- POOL:** Six lane, 25 yard pool, 8'6" starting depth, 30" blocks, non-turbulent lane markers and backstroke flags.
- TIMING:** Colorado System with back-up watches and across the board judging in case of a malfunction. All events are timed finals. Computerized scoreboard used for all lanes.
- OFFICIAL
USS RULES:** Official 2004 Short Course USA Swimming Rules shall prevail for this meet. Swimmers must be registered swimmers. Age as of October 2, 2004. Please notify meet officials of any adaptive swimmers upon arriving at the meet.

- ENTRY LIMIT:** Swimmers may compete in three (3) individual events.
- LIMITED EVENTS:** The 400 IM and 500 Free may be limited to the top 24 entered times. The 1650 may be limited to the top 16 entered times.
- 1650 Free:** Each swimmer in the 1650 Free MUST provide his/her own timer and counter.
- FEES:** Individual events \$3.00 per event. \$2.00 LSC surcharge per swimmer. Deck entries shall be \$6.00 / individual event. A processing fee of \$2.00 per swimmer, up to a team maximum of \$50, will be charged for swimmers or teams not entering their entries via Hy-tek file. Entry fees must accompany the official entry forms and are not refundable.
- ENTRY
DEADLINES:** Completed entry form, waiver and fees must be received no later than Friday September 24, 2004 by the entry chair. No phone entries will be taken. This meet is being run with **Hy-Tek swim software**. Teams wishing to submit their entries via disk or e-mail are encouraged to do so. No commlinked disks will be given to teams who do not enter their team by disk. No seed times will be changed once the entry chair has seeded the meet. Please note any special requirements for adaptive swimmers on the entry form.
- ADMISSIONS:** Spectators over 13 years old are \$2.00 and includes heat sheets.
- PARKING:** Parking is available in the west lot.
- FINAL
RESULTS:** One copy of meet results will be sent to each team represented. All others wishing results can order them at the admissions table for \$5.00 per copy. Teams will be responsible to pick up their commlinked disk following the completion of the meet. No disks will be mailed with final results.
- CONDUCT:** Each team is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers.
- AWARDS:** None
- FOOD:** A limited selection of food and beverages will be available.

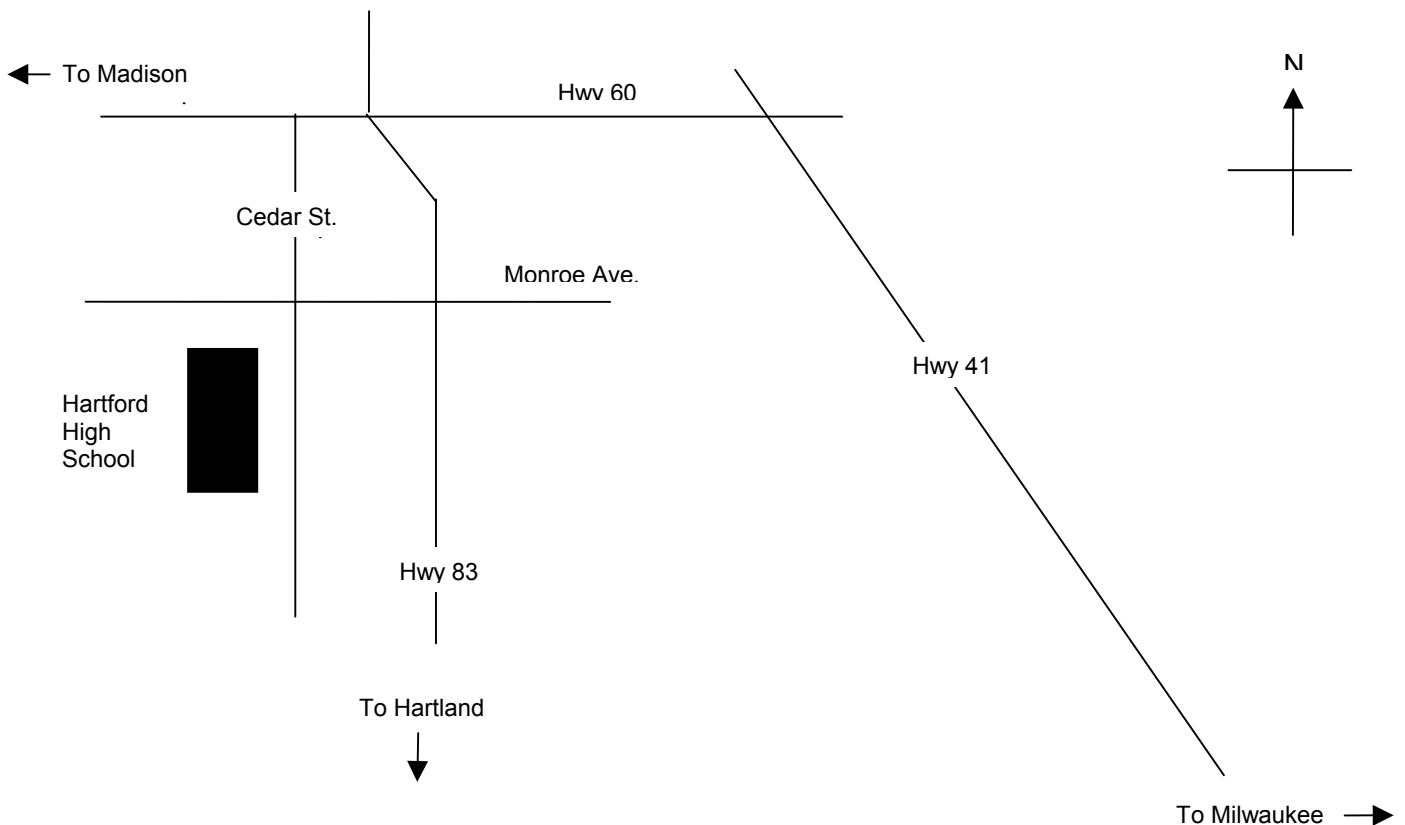
