

**2000 WISCONSIN STATE LONG COURSE CHAMPIONSHIP**  
**Hosted by: MEQUON AREA SWIM TEAM - GREATER OZAUKEE SWIM TEAM**

**Sanction #00 - 68**

- Date: Thursday, July 27 - Sunday, July 30, 2000
- Location: Schroeder Aquatic Center - Brown Deer, WI  
The Aquatic Center is an 8 lane, 50 meter pool with non-turbulent lane markers and backstroke flags. Pool depth at starting end is 7 ft. Block height is 30 in.
- Timing: Colorado System with 1 back up button and 2 back up watches per lane.
- Official Rules: Current USS and Wisconsin Swimming Rules shall govern the conduct of this meet. Swimmers must be registered Wisconsin USS swimmers with their age as of July 27, 2000.

- Warm-up & Start: Thursday Timed Finals AM session: warmups 8:30 - 9:50 am; Meet start 10:00 am  
Thursday PM session: warmups *tentative* 3:00 - 4:00pm; Meet start *tentative* 4:05 PM  
Fri/Sat prelims: warmups 8:30-9:30 am; meet start 9:35 am  
Sunday prelims: warmups 7:30-8:30 am; meet start 8:35 am  
Fri/Sat PM sessions: warmups TBA\*  
Fri/Sat Finals: warmups *tentative* 5:00 - 6:00 PM; meet start *tentative* 6:05 PM  
Sunday Finals: warmups *tentative* 3:00-4:00 PM; meet start *tentative* 4:10 PM  
The first 30 minutes of the warm-up will be circle swim. The final 30 minutes will be circle swim in lanes 2, 6, and 7; push pace in lanes 1 & 8; and sprints in lanes 3, 4, 5. Additional sprint lanes added as needed.
- Please note that all afternoon and evening start time are *tentative* only.  
The official warm-up schedule will be posted on [www.WISCONSINSWIMMING.org](http://www.WISCONSINSWIMMING.org) by Tuesday, July 25.
- Entry Deadline: All waivers, completed entry forms, entry disks and fees must be received no later than **Tuesday, July 18, 2000** by the Entry Chair. This meet is being run with Hy-Tek Swim Software. All express mail **must be pre-signed** so it will not require a signature for delivery. Teams are encouraged to submit their entries via disk. Name the meet WI LC 00. You must enclose a hard copy of your entry along with your disk. Please submit times in LC meters. Teams who submit entries via commlink disk may pick up their final results disk at the conclusion of the meet.  
Additional entries will be accepted until **noon on Monday, July 24, 2000**. Only times achieved between July 18 and July 23 will be accepted. No changes in events or times will be accepted after July 24. Only additional entries will be accepted by phone (262) 243-5854 or fax (262)243-9778.
- Entry Limit: Swimmers may compete in a total of six (6) individual events for the meet, limit of three(3) per day, including time trials, plus relays. Relay only swimmers must be listed on the relay only entry form.
- Fees: Entry Fees established by the LSC:  
**LSC Splash Fee** \$2.00 per swimmer 12 & Under entered in at least one individual event.  
\$5.00 per swimmer 13 & Over entered in at least one individual event.  
**Note:** Relay only swimmers are exempt and do not pay the Splash Fee  
**Individual Events:** \$4.00 per event 13 & over swimmers  
\$3.00 per event 12 & under swimmers  
**Relays:** \$10.00 per relay  
**Make all checks payable to: MAST**
- Proof of Time: Competitors not swimming equal to or faster than the meet time standard must prove the meet time standard with printed meet results or pay a \$50.00 fine per event. Times from this meet will not be accepted for Proof of Time at this meet. Proof must be provided before that

person swims another event or before that swimmer's team competes in any further relays. All proofs must be completed by the conclusion of Sunday's events. There will be no refunds for proofs after that time. The Proof of Time Table will be located in front of the glass office on deck.

- Meet Format:** The meet will be a prelim/final meet for the 13 & over swimmers and a timed final for the 12 & under swimmers. The top 16 individuals in the 13-14 and Senior events qualifying for finals except in the timed final events (400 IM, 800 free, 1500 free).  
All individual events will be preseeded except for the Senior 1500 free. Swimmers report directly to the blocks in all pre-seeded events as assigned in the heat sheet. The Senior 1500 will be a check-in event. The top 8 swimmers checked in for the Senior 1500 will swim in finals. Check-in must be completed 30 minutes prior to the start of the session in which they are scheduled. The 1500 free will run following the relays in Prelims, but prior to the relays in finals.
- Relays** will be pre-seeded timed final events. The top 16 relays of the Senior 400 free and 400 Medley will swim in the finals. The top 8 relays of the 13-14 400 free and Medley will swim in finals. All 200 relays will be swam to completion in the prelims. First and last names, ages, four digit ID # and the order of the swimmers must be on the back of all relay cards. Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in the relay being disqualified. Hy-Tek users should submit entries for their "relay only" swimmers by entering them in the following events:  
**201 (girls)      Senior 25 Freestyle (seed at NT)      202 (boys)**
- Coaches Meeting:** There will be a coaches' meeting scheduled on Thursday and each day of the meet prior to each session or as needed. Coaches will be notified of the meeting location and time. Coaches packets can be picked up at the start of the meet at the table in front of the glass office. All outstanding entry fees must be paid in full at the time the packet is picked up. Please display your coaching credentials at all times while on deck at the meet.
- Hospitality:** There will be a hospitality area in the room located next to the ancillary pool on the northwest end of the building. Food and beverages will be provided free of charge to officials and coaches.
- Final Results:** One copy of meet results will be sent to each participating team. Additional copies may be ordered at the Admissions table for \$12.00 per copy. Clubs who submitted their entries on disk will receive results also on disk. Please try to pick up your disk at the end of the meet.
- Conduct:** Each team is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers and parents. Only coaches, swimmers and meet workers are allowed on deck and in the lower bleachers. Anyone not complying with meet, pool and/or building rules, at the discretion of the referee, will be removed from the premises or disqualified from further participation in the meet.

- Admissions:** Admissions for all Prelims and Timed Finals Sessions will be \$3.00 for all spectators 12 and over. Heat Sheets will be \$3.00 for each session and must be purchased separately. Admissions for Finals will be \$2.00 and will include a heat sheet.
- Awards:** Individual 1 - 8 Medals    9 - 16 Ribbons  
Relays 1 - 3 Medals    4 - 16 Ribbons  
State Championship T-shirts will be awarded to the winners in each event (limit one shirt per swimmer) All awards must be picked up at the conclusion of Sunday's events. No awards will be mailed.
- High Point:** Individual High Point 1-3 Boy/Girl per age group  
Age Group Team awards 1-3  
Overall Team awards 1-10
- Scoring:** Individual Events - 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1  
Relay Events: Double points
- Food:** The Brown Deer Health Department prohibits food or beverages being brought into the Schroeder Aquatic Center. Athletes are allowed to bring refreshments, but no glass is allowed.

There will be a fine selection of food and beverages available during the meet in the cafeteria.

**Individual Scratch Rule:**

*Pre-seeded events:* Each swimmer shall report promptly to the starting blocks prior to the start of each race in which the swimmer is entered. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event shall not be penalized. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing a preliminary heat when finals are scheduled shall not be penalized.

*Events Seeded on the Deck:* Any swimmer entered in an individual event that is seeded on the deck, who has checked in for the event, must swim in the event unless the swimmer notifies the clerk of course before the seeding for that event has begun that the swimmer wishes to scratch. Failure to scratch prior to seeding and not swimming the event will result in the swimmer being barred from the next individual event in which the swimmer is entered on that day or the next day, whichever is first. Events seed on the deck shall be closed for seeding no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session in which the event is scheduled.

**Relay Scratch Rule:**

*Pre-seeded Events:* Any relay team entered in a pre-seeded event that fails to compete in or report for that event shall not be penalized.

*Events seeded on the Deck:* Any relay entered on a relay event that is seeded at the meet, that has been checked in and the swimmers' names declared for that event must swim the event unless the clerk of course is notified before the seeding for that event is begun that the relay team wishes to scratch. A relay team member failing to appear ready to swim for the relay event shall be barred from their next individual event in which the swimmer is entered, either that or the next meet day. The relay team members who do appear ready to swim shall not be penalized for failure of the other relay team members to appear. Exceptions: Relay teams or team members who give acceptable notification to the referee of illness, injury, or that failure to compete caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer(s) shall not be penalized. Finals shall include those events deck seeded but swum as timed finals in prelim finals competition. Typically, those are distance events and relay events.

**Scratching from Bonus, Consols, or Finals:**

Any swimmer qualifying for a bonus heat, consolation final or final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said bonus, consolation final, or final race shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. Disqualification under this section shall apply only to swimmers qualifying based on the original preliminary results. In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition, the Referee shall fill the C, B, or A when possible with the next qualified swimmers(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the finals. When bonus/consolation finals have not yet been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known to the referee, the referee shall pre seed the bonus/consolation final and final, if necessary, by inserting the alternates(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in finals. If a bonus or consolation final has been contested, the companion final shall be swum without reseeding for empty lanes. Finals shall include those events deck seeded but swum as timed finals in prelim finals competition. Swimmers should declare their intent to scratch thirty (30) minutes after the initial posting of the individual event results. Swimmers must officially scratch thirty (30) minutes after their last individual event of the day.

## **TIME TRIALS**

### **Sanction #00-69**

- Times:** At the conclusion of Sunday prelim sessions and Sunday finals.
- Events:** Time Trials for Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday events will be at the conclusion of Sunday prelims session. ONLY Sunday events will at the conclusion of Sunday Finals session.
- Fees:** \$5.00/individual event  
\$12.00/relay event
- Registration:** At the meet management table located in front of the glass office. Registration will be accepted during the prelim and final sessions up to the last event each day.
- Procedures:** Swimmers(s) will sign up for an event at the meet management table. Swimmers will fill out a seed card including the swimmer's name, age, team, event name and number and seed time. Seed card and event fee must be turned in at the table before the deadline. A meeting for all time trial participants and timers will be held prior to the start of time trials. Cards with heat and lane assignments will be handed out at this meeting. It is the swimmer's responsibility to be ready to swim when his/her event, name and lane number are called. The referee will not hold the start of the event waiting for a swimmer or timer. An announcement will be made that time trials are beginning and swimmers and their timers should report to the meeting immediately.
- Meet Host Provides:** Officials, Colorado System Operator, Meet management
- Swimmers Provide** Timers, watches, and counters if needed.
- Reminders:** The maximum number of individual events in one day is three (3). This includes time trials. For example, on Sunday a swimmers may only swim 3 events per day including  
3 time trials  
3 meet events  
3 combined time trial and meet events
- Time Trials begin promptly. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to be at the blocks with his/her timers and watches ready to swim
