Sundays Morning Session will begin at 9:05AM

Lane 8 during the Sunday morning session will be designated for 8/Under Swimmers ONLY. Sunday's PM session will begin promptly after the completion of the morning session. A Timeline will be emailed to all teams and posted on Wisconsin Swimming's website prior to the meet.
