3.4.1	<u>A Meet Host shall Meets should be planned its Meet to terminate within a maximum of eight (8) hours of competitive events in any one (1) day.</u> With the exception of <u>LSC</u> Championship Meets, the program, <u>including individual events and relay events</u> , in all other age group competitions below the National Motivational A time level shall be arranged to allow

<u>individual events and relay events</u>, in all other age group competitions below the National Motivational A time level shall be arranged to allow for <u>completing all</u> events, <u>not including warm-ups</u>, for swimmers twelve (12) years and younger to be completed in four (4) hours or less for a timed finals sessions or in a total of eight (8) hours or less <del>per day</del> for a preliminaries and finals Meet <u>per day</u>.

Rationale: Clarifies that relays are included and that warm-ups are excluded from the time requirements. Consistent with USA Swimming Rule 205.3.1.f.
