Host	Watertown Aquatic Team (WAT)
Date	Saturday, January 18, 2003
Location`	Waterloo High School, 865 North Monroe, Waterloo WI
Pool	Six (6) lanes, 25-yard pool with non-turbulent lane markers, backstroke flags, and 28" blocks. Pool depth is 3.5 ft. at its shallow end and 10 ft. at its deepest end. Ample parking available in the high school parking lot and seating in the pool area. The starting block pool depth is 10 ft.
Timing	Colorado electronic timing system with touch pads and manual back-up timing buttons and horn start. Each lane will have two timers with electronic stopwatches. All events will be timed finals.
Schedule	Meet will start at 8:35am Warm-ups for the AM session will be from 7:30am – 8:30 am. 7:30 – 8:00 Circle swim all lanes. 8:00 – 8:30 am Circle swim lanes 1 & 6. Push/Pace 50 s lanes 2 & 5. One way sprints lanes 3 & 4. This procedure will be repeated for the afternoon session. Warm-ups for the PM session will not begin before 12:00 am.
Meet Format	Clerk of Course will be staging 8&U swimmers near the starting blocks. All other swimmers must be at the starting blocks at the start of their events.
Rules	2003 Short Course rules will apply. All swimmers must be USS registered. All out of state swimmers must bring their USS card to the meet. Age as of January 18, 2003. Deck entries will be allowed into open lanes only and will close 30 minutes prior to the session start. Swimmers not reporting to the blocks at the start of their event will be scratched.

Entry Deadline	Waiver and fees must be received no later than January 11, 2003. Entries via HY-TEK commlink are encouraged. Please send a hard copy with disk. Please use a separate paper for male and female swimmers.
Entry Limits	The first 1200 swims will be accepted. Swimmers may compete in 4 individual events and 2 relays events.
Entry Fees	\$2.50 per individual event and a \$1.25 splash fee per swimmer. \$8.00 per relay event. Fees are not refundable unless the meet is full.

- Coaches Packs Coaches packs will be held for pick up in the pool office. A current USS Coaches membership card will be required to receive each pack.
- Awards: Commemorative color mylar medals for each participating swimmer will be awarded.
Ribbons for individual events places 1-6.
6&U will swim with, but be awarded separately from 8&U swimmers in individual events.
Ribbons for individual heat winners.
Ribbons for relay events places 1-3.
- Admissions Admission for persons 12 and over will be \$2.00. Heat sheets will be available for \$2.00.
- Adaptive Swimmers Please notify the meet referee so that any special needs may be accommodated.
- General Information One copy of final results will be given to each team.
Additional copies are available for \$5.00.
Radios are permitted only with the use of headphones. TV's are not permitted in the pool area.
