FACILITY: An 8-lane, 25-yard pool with a starting and turn depth of 4-½ feet. It has regulation-height starting blocks (30") and ample viewing area for athletes and spectators.

The schedule for additional breaks will be determined after all entries have been received and a timeline has been generated. This schedule will be posted at www.badgeraquatics.com and at www.wisconsinsswimming.org as soon as it is available.

WARM-UPS: General warm-ups/circle swimming in all lanes for each warm-up session. Push-pace and sprint lanes will be opened & closed as necessary.

The diving well will remain open throughout the competition sessions. However, **THE POOL WILL BE CLOSED DURING AWARDS PRESENTATIONS!**

Note: The spectator bleachers and pool deck will be closed during the breaks following the am session.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may compete in **FOUR** individual events per day plus relays up to a maximum of **SEVEN** individual events for the meet. This limit includes any individual events from the Senior portion of the meet the preceding weekend. Teams may enter an unlimited number of relays with no qualifications. For all teams using Hy-Tek Team Manager for their entries, please enter all RELAY ONLY swimmers into the following event so they can be included in your commlink (you will not be billed for these events!):

201 (girls) Senior 25 Free 202 (boys) seed at NT

ENTRY DEADLINE: The entry chair must receive a completed entry form, signed waiver and fees no later than **Wednesday, February 20, 2002**. No entries will be taken over the phone. If sending entries by express mail or service, signature requirement must be waived. This meet will be run using Hy-Tek meet manager. All teams are encouraged to submit entries on disk in the Hy-Tek commlink format. Additional Relay Only swimmers will be accepted as a deck entry, but any additions must be completed within the first 30 minutes of that day's warm-ups (by 4:45 pm Friday or 7:30 am Saturday and Sunday).

ENTRY FEES: \$3.00 LSC splash fee per swimmer, \$3.00 per individual event and \$12.00 per relay. Please note that Relay-only swimmers **MUST** also pay the \$3.00 LSC splash fee.

PROOF OF TIME: Swimmers who fail to achieve the time standard at the meet must prove they have achieved the time standard with a printed meet result or pay a \$50.00 fine before swimming their next event or the swimmer's team competes in any further relays. All swimmers disqualifying in individual events must also prove their times. The **PROOF-OF-TIME** table will be located in the small glass office to the west of the main office.

DECK SEEDING: Deck Entries will not be accepted. Deck Registrations will not be accepted.

TIMING SYSTEM: All events will be timed using a Colorado Timing System with horn start, touch pads, one button, with 2 watches as backup.

ADAPTIVE SWIMMERS: Please indicate on the entries form any special needs for those athletes requiring assistance. Also, please inform the head official of those needs prior to the start of the meet.

All awards must be picked up at the meet. Awards will not be mailed. State Championship T-shirts will be awarded to the winner of each event including relays (limit one per swimmer).

Scores will be added to the 13 & Over State Meet and team awards will be presented at the conclusion of the meet. Breaks for awards presentations will be determined once a meet timeline has been generated. The meet timeline will be posted online as soon as it is determined.

COACHES: Meet packets can be picked up in the main glass office adjacent to the pool deck. All outstanding entry fees must be paid at the time the meet packet is picked up. There will be a brief coaches meeting before the start of each day's meet. Meeting location will be announced during warm-ups.

- SCORING: This meet will be scored through 16th place, with double points for relays.
- OFFICIALS: Starter/Referee will be appointed by Wisconsin LSC.

- MEET CONDUCT: Each club is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers. Any person who, in the opinion of the Meet Director or Meet Marshall, is harmful to others or to other's property will be required to leave the competition.
Please sit in the designated areas for teams and spectators. All spectator seating is in the upper bleachers. All swimmers must keep their swim bags in the TEAM seating areas, not the spectator seating areas. In accordance to USA Swimming rules and University of Wisconsin facility rules, **NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK.** By order of the Madison Fire Department, there is no standing in the aisles and the area behind/under the bleachers must be kept clear.
- ADMISSIONS: Programs will be available for \$20.00 for the weekend. No separate admissions fee will be charged.

- PARKING: Free parking is located across the street after 3:00 pm Friday and for the duration of the meet. **PERSONS PARKING IN THIS LOT PRIOR TO 3:00 PM FRIDAY WILL BE TICKETED!**
- FINAL RESULTS: Each participating club shall receive one copy of final meet results. Additional copies of final results can be ordered at the heat sheet sales table for \$15.00.
