DATE: July 22-24, 2005

LOCATION: Walter Schroeder Aquatic Center  
9250 N. Green Bay Road  
Brown Deer, WI 53209

FACILITY: 8-lane, 50-meter pool with a minimum starting and turn depth of 6.5 feet. It has regulation-height starting blocks (29.5") and ample viewing area for athletes and spectators.

CLASSIFICATION: State Championship Time Standards, Wisconsin LSC-dictated

RULES & ELIGIBILITY: 2005 USA and Wisconsin LSC rules shall prevail for this meet. Swimmers must be Registered with USA Swimming.

**All 10-Under Events are Timed Finals but the fastest heat of each individual event will swim with finals in the evening (no positive check in for any 10&U events). 11-12 Events are Prelim/Finals unless noted (the top 8 swimmers will qualify for finals).**

The schedule for additional breaks will be determined by the meet director after all entries have been received and a timeline has been generated. This schedule will be posted at [www.wisconsinswimming.org](http://www.wisconsinswimming.org) as soon as it is available. The pool will be open during the breaks at the discretion of the meet director.

WARM-UPS: General warm-ups/circle swimming in all lanes for each warm-up session. Push-pace and sprint lanes will be opened & closed as necessary by the meet director and marshals.

The Schroeder YMCA's 6 lane, 25 yard pool will have some availability for warming down. It will only be open during the competition portion of the meet (not during warm-ups) or as determined by the meet director.

**ENTRIES:**

**10-Under swimmers** may enter a maximum of 7 individual events plus relays and time trials. However, these entries are limited to 4 individual events per day in any combination of meet events and time trials

**11-12 swimmers** may enter a maximum of 7 individual events plus relays and time trials. However, these entries are limited to 3 individual events per day in any combination of meet events and time trials

**Relays:** Teams may enter an "A" relay regardless of athlete counts. **If you want to enter a "B" relay, your team must have at least 5 individual qualifiers in that age group for each gender (For example, 5 10&U boys qualified for the meet allows you to swim an A and B relay).** If you have 9 athletes, then you can have a "C" relay and so on. 10&U relays will be swum to completion in the morning sessions. The fastest 8 checked in relays will swim at night for all 11-12 relays with all other heats being swum to completion in the morning sessions. Relay only swimmers should be added to event 201 or 202.

Additional relays can be entered after the initial entry deadline of July 12<sup>th</sup> if a team gains additional qualifiers between July 12<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. Teams must send a new commlink file to [ssty.sa@ymcamke.org](mailto:ssty.sa@ymcamke.org) if this happens and adhere to the entry deadlines outlined below.

**\*\*Bonus Event: If you have qualified in 1-6 events for the meet, you may swim another event that you have not qualified for. However, you are only allowed ONE bonus event no matter how many events you have qualified for.**

**\*\*\*Please note – Meet management needs bonus entries to be included in the commlink file but also hand written out in the email with the file. This way we can decipher what is an exception and what is a bonus event.**

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** The entry chair must receive a complete commlink file no later than **Tuesday, July 12, 2005**. All files should be emailed. You will receive a confirmation email and an athlete/entry report from the entry chair. Emailed additional entries will be accepted until **12:00PM on July 18, 2005** for anyone qualifying between **July 12th, 2005 and July 17th, 2005. This is only for additional events not for updating times.** Signed waiver and fees are due no later than **Thursday, July 21, 2005**. No entries will be changed once the entries have been posted on the **Wisconsin Swimming** web site **Tuesday, July 19, 2005** unless it is a meet management entry mistake. No entries will be taken over the phone. This meet will be run using Hy-Tek meet manager.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$3.00 LSC splash fee per swimmer.  
\$5.00 for 10-Under individual events  
\$6.00 for 11-12 individual events  
\$16.00 per relay.  
Please note: Relay-only swimmers **MUST** also pay the \$3.00 LSC splash fee and be entered in 201 or 202.

**PROOF OF TIME:** All submitted entry times will be compared to the USA Swimming SWIMS database throughout the course of the meet. Swimmers who fail to achieve the time standard at the meet, and are not able to be proven through the SWIMS database must prove they have achieved the time standard with a printed meet result or pay a \$50.00 fine before swimming their next event or the swimmer's team competes in any further relays. All swimmers disqualifying in individual events must also prove their times if not in the database. The PROOF-OF-TIME table will be located in front of the small glass office. Swimmers whose times are listed in the USA Swimming National Times data base will not have to come to the proof of times table. It is meet management's understanding that all USA swimming sanctioned events will be in the database. If a time is not in the database, you must present a proof of time to the table. Time trials from this meet will not be accepted for proof of time.

**DECK SEEDING:** Deck Entries will not be accepted. Deck Registrations will not be accepted.

**NON CONFORMING TIMES:** DO NOT CONVERT. Swimmers must be entered at their best time. All courses may be used. Non-conforming times will be seeded after LCM times. The order used for seeding will be LCM-SCM-SCY.

**TIMING SYSTEM:** All events will be timed using a Colorado Timing System with horn start, touch pads, two buttons, with 1 watch as backup.

**DISABLED SWIMMERS:** Please indicate on the entries form any special needs for those athletes requiring assistance. If you think you may qualify as an disabled swimmer please contact the age group chair or the senior chair for time standards. Also, please inform the head official of those needs prior to the start of the meet.

**All awards must be picked up at the meet. Awards will not be mailed. State Championship T-shirts will be awarded to the winner of each event including relays (limit one per swimmer).**

AGE GROUP TEAM AWARDS: 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Place  
TEAM AWARDS: 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Place  
Breaks for awards presentations will be determined once a meet timeline has been generated. The meet timeline will be posted online as soon as it is determined.

**COACHES:** Meet packets can be picked up at the table in front of the main glass office. All outstanding entry fees must be paid at the time the meet packet is picked up. There will be a brief coaches meeting before the start of each day's meet. Meeting location will be announced during warm-ups.

**SCORING:** This meet will be scored through 16<sup>th</sup> place, with double points for relays.

- OFFICIALS: Appointed by Wisconsin LSC.
- MEET CONDUCT: Each club is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers. Any person who, in the opinion of the Meet Director or Meet Marshall, is harmful to others or to other's property will be required to leave the competition. Please sit in the designated areas for teams and spectators. All spectators seating is in the upper bleachers. All swimmers must keep their swim bags in the TEAM seating areas, not the spectator seating areas. In accordance to USA Swimming rules, NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK. By order of the Brown Deer Fire Department, there is no standing in the aisles and stairwells. There will be no resting area in any door ways or hallways. No chairs, coolers, etc. will be allowed in the bleachers and/or hallways.
- ADMISSIONS: There will be a charge for admission of \$5 for prelims and \$3 for finals. Prelim Heat Sheets will be available for free on our website at [www.wisconsinswimming.org](http://www.wisconsinswimming.org) by Wednesday, July 20<sup>th</sup>. Please print them out at home as there will be a charge at the meet and very limited quantities. Finals heat sheets will be available for \$2. An all session pass (including finals heat sheets) will be available for \$25.
- PARKING: A limited amount of parking will be located in the west parking lot of the Schroeder YMCA. There will be additional free parking available in the park and ride to the south of the Applebee's. A frequent shuttle will run between the facility and the parking lot. The times of the shuttle will be posted as we get closer to the meet. We would encourage everyone to use the shuttle and to car pool to the meet from hotels during prelims. There will not be a shuttle for the finals sessions.
- FINAL RESULTS: A meet back-up will be posted at [www.wisconsinswimming.org](http://www.wisconsinswimming.org) on Monday, July 25<sup>th</sup>.
- CONCESSIONS: Delicious hot and cold foods will be available for purchase throughout the meet. NO GLASS CONTAINERS ALLOWED ON DECK!!!

**Please read through the scratch rules outlined below:**

**Ind. Scratch Rule:**

*Pre-seeded Events* – Each swimmer shall report promptly to the starting blocks prior to the start of each race in which the swimmer is entered. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event shall not be penalized. Any swimmer not reporting for a competing in a preliminary heat when finals are scheduled shall not be penalized.

*Events Seeded on the Deck* – Any swimmer entered in an individual event that is seeded on the deck, who has checked in for the event, must swim in the event unless the swimmer notifies the clerk of course before the seeding for that event has begun that the swimmer wishes to scratch. Failure to scratch prior to seeding and not swimming the event will result in the swimmer being barred from the next individual event in which the swimmer is entered on that day or the next meet day, whichever is first. Events seeded on the deck shall be closed for seeding no earlier than thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the session in which the event is scheduled.

**Relay Scratch Rule:**

*Pre-seeded Events:* -- Any relay team entered in a pre-seeded event that fails to compete in or report for that event shall not be penalized.

*Events Seeded on the Deck* – Any relay entered in a relay event that is seeded at the meet, that has been checked in and the swimmers' names declared for that event, must swim the event unless the clerk of course is notified before the seeding for that event is begun that the relay team wishes to scratch. A relay team member failing to appear ready to swim for the relay event shall be barred from their next individual event in which the swimmer is entered, either that or the next meet day. The relay team members who do appear ready to swim shall not be penalized for failure of the other

relay team members to appear. Exceptions: Relay teams or team members who give acceptable notification to the referee of illness, injury, or that failure to compete caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer(s) shall not be penalized. Finals shall include those events deck seeded but swum as timed finals in prelim finals competition. Typically, those are the distance events and relay events.

**Scratching from Consolation Finals or Finals:**

Any swimmer qualifying for a consolation final or final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said consolation final or final race shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. Disqualification under this section shall only apply to swimmers qualifying based on the original preliminary results. In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition, the referee shall fill the Bonus/Consolation or Final Heat when possible, with the next qualified swimmer(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the finals. When bonus/consolation finals have not yet been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known to the referee, the referee shall re-seed the consolation final and final, if necessary, by inserting the alternates(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in finals. If a consolation final has been contested, the companion final shall be swum without reseeding for empty lanes. Finals shall include those events deck seeded but swum as timed finals in prelim / finals competition. Swimmers must declare their intent to scratch thirty (30) minutes after the initial posting of the individual event results. Swimmers must officially scratch thirty (30) minutes after their last individual event of the day.

*Time Trials*  
Sanction #2005-085WI

Time trials are available only to those swimmers entered in the 12&Under State Championship Meet.

- Times:** Time Trials will be offered three days and/or as time permits and at the discretion of the meet director(s) as per LSC mandate.
- Events:** See meet order of events listing.
- Fees:** \$8.00/individual event and \$18.00/relay event.
- Registration:** At the meet management table located near the glass the office. Entries will be accepted during the prelim and final sessions up to a half hour before the end of the session. (Swimmers in the last event of the day have up until ten minutes after the end of that event to sign up for time trials.)
- Procedures:** Swimmer(s) will sign up for an event at the meet management table. Swimmer(s) will fill out a seed card at the table – swimmer's name, age, team, event name and seed time. Seed card and event fee must be turned in to the table before the registration deadline. A meeting for all time trial participants and timers will be held prior to the start of time trials. Cards with heat and lane assignments will be handed out at this meeting. It is the swimmer's responsibility to be ready to swim when his/her event, name, and lane number are called. The referee will not hold the start of the event, waiting for a swimmer (or timer) to show. An announcement will be made that time trials are beginning and swimmers and their two timers should report to the meeting immediately. ALL Time Trial cards (whether or not a swimmer swims a desired time) MUST be turned in at the end of each heat.
- Meet Host Provides:** Officials, Timing System Operator, Meet Management
- Swimmers Provide:** Two (2) Timers, Two (2) Watches, and Counter (if needed).
- Reminders:** \*The maximum number of individual events in one day is three (3) for the 11-12 swimmers. It is 4 per day for 10&U. This includes time trials. (USA 102.2.5 and 102.2.6) This means that on Sunday, for example, a swimmer may swim 3 individual events total, including a combination of: 1) only time trials, 2) combined time trials and meet events, or 3) only meet events.
- \*Time trials begin promptly. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to be at the blocks, complete with his/her two timers (and two watches), ready to swim.
- \*Timers must turn in their cards whether or not a swimmer achieves a desired cut time.
