- Date:** July 28-30, 2006
- Location:** Walter Schroeder Aquatic Center, 9250 North Green Bay Road, Brown Deer, Wisconsin 53209
- Facility:** The Schroeder Aquatic Center is an 8-lane, 50-meter pool with non-turbulent lane markers and backstroke flags. Pool depth has a minimum starting and turn depth of 6 ½ feet. Block height is 29.5”
- Classification:** State Championship Time Standards, Wisconsin LSC dictated.
- Rules & Eligibility:** 2006 USA and Wisconsin LSC rules shall prevail for this meet. Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming with their age as of July 28, 2006.
- Timing System:** All events will be timed using a Colorado Timing System with horn start, touch pads, two buttons, with 2 watches as backup.
- Head Officials:** LSC appointed

- Warm-ups:** General warm-ups/circle swimming in all lanes for each warm-up session. Push-pace and sprint lines will be opened and closed as necessary by the Meet Director and Meet Marshals.
- The Schroeder YMCA’s 6-lane, 25-yard pool will have one lane available for warming down. It will only be open during the competition portion of the meet (not during warm-ups) or as determined by the Meet Director. The 12 & U swimmers utilizing the facility will be supervised by meet event staff.

- The Meet Director will determine the schedule for additional breaks after all entries have been received and a timeline has been generated. This schedule will be posted at www.wisconsinsswimming.org as soon as it is available. The pool will be open during breaks at the discretion of the Meet Director. Breaks can be added or taken out, as well as shortened or lengthened, at the Meet Director’s discretion throughout the course of the meet.
- Entries:** **10 & Under swimmers** may enter a maximum of 7 individual events plus relays and time trials. Please note, these entries are limited to 4 individual events per day in any combination of meet events and time trials.
11-12 swimmers may enter a maximum of 7 individual events plus relays and time trials. Please note, these entries are limited to 3 individual events per day in any combination of meet events and times trials
- Bonus Event:** If a swimmer has qualified in 1-6 events for the meet, s/he may swim one other event that s/he has not qualified for. However, the swimmer is only allowed ONE bonus event no matter how many events s/he has qualified for. Please note – Meet Management needs the bonus entries to be included in the commlink file, but also typed out in the email sent with the file – doing this will assist Meet

Management in deciphering Bonus events from exceptions. Anyone entered in a bonus event who achieves a qualifying time in that event between July 18 and July 23 may update the time in that event only and a new bonus event may be added as long as the maximum of 7 individual events is not exceeded.

Entry Deadline: No entries will be taken over the phone. Entries will be accepted from the swim team entry person only. This meet will run using Hy-Tek Meet Manager.
Initial Entries: The entry chair must receive a complete commlink file, hard copy, signed waiver and fees no later than **6:00 pm, Tuesday, July 18, 2006**. All entry files should be emailed. You will receive a confirmation email from the entry chair. All express mail must pre-signed so it will not require a signature for delivery.
Additional Entries: Emailed additional entries will be accepted until **Noon on July 24, 2006** for events in which a swimmer obtains a cut time for the first time in a meet between **July 18, 2006 and July 23, 2006. This is only for additional events, not for updating seed times.**
Please note: No entries will be changed once the entries have been posted on the Wisconsin Swimming website Tuesday, July 25, 2006 unless it is a Meet Management entry mistake.

Seed Times: **DO NOT CONVERT.** Swimmers must be entered at their best time. All courses may be used. Non-conforming times will be seeded after LCM times. The order used for seeding will be LCM-SCM-SCY.

Relays:

- Teams may enter an “A” relay regardless of their athlete counts. **If coaches want to enter a “B” relay, the team must have at least 5 individual qualifiers in that age-group for each gender (for example, five 10 & Under Boys qualified for the meet allows an “A” and “B” relay) – if a team has 9 athletes, a “C” relay can be added and so on.** Relay only swimmers must be added to event 201 (girls) and event 202 (boys).
- Additional relays can be entered after the initial entry deadline of July 18, 2006 if a team gains additional qualifiers between July 18, 2006 and July 23, 2006. Teams must send a new commlink file to lewno@execpc.com if this happens and adhere to the entry deadlines outlined above.
- First and last names, ages, and the order of the swimmers must be listed on all relay cards.
- Additional relay-only swimmers may be added during the meet, *but must be entered in the meet management office at least 30 minutes before the start of any session in which they swim or the relay on which they swim will be disqualified.*

Entry Fees: \$3.00 WI LSC splash fee per swimmer.
\$5.00 for 10 & Under individual events.
\$6.00 for 11-12 individual events.
\$16.00 per relay.
Please note, relay only swimmers **MUST** pay the \$3.00 WI LSC splash fee and be entered in events 201 (girls) and 202 (boys).

Proof of Time: All submitted entry times will be compared to the USA Swimming SWIMS database throughout the course of the meet. Swimmers who fail to achieve the state qualifying time standard (includes disqualifications) at the meet and whose times cannot be found in the SWIMS database must prove they have achieved the time standard with printed meet results or pay a \$50.00 fine prior to swimming their next event or the swimmer’s team competes in any further relays. The Proof of Time table will be located in front of the small glass office. Swimmers whose times are listed in the SWIMS database will not have to prove their times. It is Meet Management’s understanding that all USA Swimming sanctioned events will be in the database. If a time is not in the database, coaches must present proof of time. Time trial results from this meet will not be accepted for proof of time. All proofs must be completed by the conclusion of Sunday’s events. There will be no refunds for proofs after that time.

Meet Format:

- The 10 & Under 400 Free is a positive check-in event. All other 10 & Under events are Timed Finals, with the fastest heat of each individual event swimming with Finals in the evenings.
- 11-12 events are Prelim/Final unless otherwise noted (the top 8 swimmers will qualify for Finals).
- The 11-12 800 Free, the 11-12 400 IM, the 11-12 400 Free, and the 10 & Under 400 Free will be positive check in, timed final events with the top 8 checked in swimmers swimming in finals. During prelims these events will run fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys.
- 10 & Under relays will be swum to completion in the morning sessions.

- The 11-12 relays will be positive check in, timed final events with the fastest 8 checked-in relays swimming in finals with all other heats swum to completion in the morning session. Prelim events will run fastest to slowest.

Positive Check In: Positive check in must be made at the meet management table at least 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the session in which the event is swim.

Individual events: The 11-12 800 Free, the 11-12 400 IM, the 11-12 400 Free, and the 10 & Under 400 Free will be positive check in, timed final events.

Relay events: The 11-12 200 Free Relay, the 11-12 200 Medley Relay, and the 11-12 400 Free Relay will be positive check in, timed final events.

Deck Seeding: Deck entries and registrations will not be accepted.

Adaptive Swimmers: Please indicate on the entries form any special needs for those athletes requiring assistance. Also, please inform the head Official of those needs prior to the start of the meet. If a swimmer thinks s/he may qualify as an adaptive swimmer, please contact the Age-Group or Senior Chair for time standards.

Please read through the scratch rule outlined below:

Individual Scratch Rule:

Pre-Seeded Events – Each swimmer shall report promptly to the starting blocks prior to the start of each race in which the swimmer is entered. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event shall not be penalized. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in a preliminary heat when finals are scheduled shall not be penalized.

Events Seeded on the Deck – Any swimmer entered in an individual event that is seeded on the deck, who has checked in for the event, must swim in the event unless the swimmer notifies the Clerk of Course before the seeding for that event has begun that the swimmer wishes to scratch. Failure to scratch prior to seeding and not swimming the event will result in the swimmer being barred from the next individual event in which the swimmer is entered on that day of the next meet day, whichever is first. Events seeded on the deck shall be closed for seeding no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session in which the event is scheduled.

Relay Scratch Rule:

Pre-Seeded Events – Any relay team entered in a pre-seeded event that fails to compete in or report for that event shall not be penalized.

Events Seeded on the Deck – Any relay entered in a relay event that is seeded at the meet, that has been checked in and the swimmers' names declared for that event, must swim the event unless the Clerk of Course is notified before the seeding for that event is begun that the relay team wishes to scratch. A relay team member failing to appear ready to swim the relay event shall be barred from their next individual event in which the swimmer is entered, either that or the next meet day. The relay team members who do appear ready to swim shall not be penalized for failure of the other relay team members to appear. Exceptions: Relay teams or team members who give acceptable notification to the referee of illness, injury, or that failure to compete caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer(s) shall not be penalized. Finals shall include those events deck seeded, but swum as timed finals in Prelim/Finals competition.

Scratching from Consolation Finals or Finals:

Any swimmer qualifying for a consolation final or final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said consolation final or final race shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. Disqualification under this section shall only apply to swimmers qualifying based on the original preliminary results. In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition, the Referee shall fill the Bounce/Consolation of Final Heat when possible, with the next qualified swimmer(s). Listed alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall be based on original preliminary results prior to any scratches. These alternates shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the finals. When consolation finals have not yet been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known to the referee, the referee shall reseed the consolation final and final, if necessary, by inserting the alternate(s) in the appropriate lanes(s), filling all lanes in finals. If a consolation final has been contested, the companion final shall be swum without reseeding for empty lanes. Finals shall include those events deck seeded but swum as timed finals in prelim finals competition. Swimmers must declare their intent to scratch within thirty (30) minutes after the initial posting of the individual events results. Swimmers must officially scratch within thirty (30) minutes after their last individual event of the day

Awards:

Individual events:

Medals: 1st - 8th place

Ribbons: 9th - 16th place

Relays:

Medals: 1st - 3rd place

Ribbons: 4th - 16th place

State Championship T-Shirts will be awarded to the winner of each event (includes relay events) – limit one per swimmer.

Individual High Point Awards:	1 st – 3 rd place per age-group
Male and Female Age-Group Team Awards:	1 st – 3 rd place per age-group
Team Awards:	1 st – 10 th place

Breaks for award presentations will be determined once the meet timeline has been generated. The meet timeline will be posted on the Wisconsin Swimming website as soon as it is developed.

Any awards not picked up during the course of the meet will be bagged and handed out at the 13 & Over Wisconsin LCM State Championships (August 3-6, 2006).

- Coaches:** Meet packets can be picked up at the table in front of the main glass office. All outstanding entry fees must be paid when picking up the meet packet. There will be a brief coaches meeting before the start of each day's meet as necessary. Meeting location and time will be announced during warm-ups.
- Scoring:** 16-place scoring. Individual events (20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4- 3-2-1) and Relay events (40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2).
- Meet Conduct:** Each club is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers. Any person who, in the opinion of the Meet Director or Meet Marshal, is harmful or disrespectful to others or to other's property will be required to leave the competition. Please sit in the designated areas for teams and spectators. All spectators seating is in the upper bleachers. All swimmers must keep their swim bags in the team seating areas. In accordance with USA Swimming rules, **NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK.** By order of the Brown Deer Fire Department, there is no standing in the aisles and stairwells. There will be no resting area in any doorway or hallway. No chairs, coolers, etc will be allowed in the bleachers and/or hallways.
- Admissions:** Admissions for all prelim sessions will be \$5.00 for spectators, 12 and over. Heat Sheets for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday prelims are \$4.00 and must be purchased separately. Admissions for all final sessions will be \$5.00 and will include a heat sheet. A Gold Ticket, covering admission and heat sheet for every session, will be available for \$35.00. A Silver Ticket, covering admission for every session—without heat sheets, will be available for \$25.00.
- Parking:** A limited amount of parking will be located in the west parking lot of the Schroeder YMCA. There will be additional parking available in the park-and-ride to the south of Applebee's Restaurant which is just a short walk to the pool. We advise you to drop off your swimmer at the pool and then park your car at the park-and-ride area. We encourage use of carpooling to the meet during Prelims.
- Final Results:** A meet back-up will be posted at www.wisconsinswimming.org
- Concessions:** Hot and cold foods will be available for purchase during the meet. According to the Brown Deer Health Department, there will be no food or beverages allowed to be brought into the Schroeder Aquatic Center by parents or spectators. This includes the cafeteria area. Athletes are allowed to bring refreshments (liquid), but **NO GLASS** is allowed.
- Lost & Found:** There will be a lost and found area set up near the glass office. It is recommended that athletes do not bring expensive or valuable items to the meet. SEAY, the Schroeder YMCA, and the WI LSC are not responsible for lost items. To inquire about lost items, contact Jennifer Pennings (262-752-0387) or djpennings@wi.rr.com until August 3, 2006. Lost and found items will be donated to charity after that date.

Time Trials

WI Sanction #2006-089WI

Time Trials are available only to those swimmers entered in the 12 & Under Wisconsin LCM State Championships.

- Times:** Time Trials will be offered at the conclusion of Friday, Saturday, and Sunday prelim sessions and Sunday finals session as time permits and at the discretion of the Meet Director.
- Events:** All meet events will be offered.
- Fees:** \$8.00 for individual events and \$18.00 for relay events.
- Registration:** At the Meet Management table located near the glass office. Entries will be accepted during the Prelim and Final sessions up to 30 minutes prior to the end of the session. Swimmers in the last event of the day have 10 minutes after the end of that event to sign up for Time Trials.
- Procedure:**
- Swimmer will sign-up for an event at the Meet Management table.
 - Swimmer will fill out a seed card at the table – swimmer's name, age, team, event name and number, and seed time.
 - Seed card and event fee must be turned into the Meet Management table before the registration deadline.
 - An announcement will be made indicating the time that Time Trials will begin.
 - A meeting for all Time Trial participants and timers will be held prior to the start of Time Trials. Swimmers and timers should report to the meeting immediately.
 - Cards with heat and lane assignments will be handed out during the meeting.
 - It is the swimmer's responsibility to be ready to swim when her/his event, name, and lane number is called. The Referee will not hold the start of the event, waiting for a swimmer (or timer) to show.
 - ALL Time Trial cards (whether or not a swimmer swims a desired time) MUST be turned in at the end of each heat.
- Meet Host Provides:** Officials, Timing System Operator, and Meet Management.
- Swimmer Provides:** Two (2) timers, two (2) watches, and counter (if needed).
- Reminders:** The maximum number of individual events in one day is three (3) for 11-12 swimmers (it's 4 per day for 10 & Under swimmers) and includes Time Trials (USA 102.2.5 and 102.2.6). This means that on Sunday (for example) an 11-12 swimmer may swim 3 individual events total, including a combination of:
- 1) only Time Trials
 - 2) combined Time Trials and meet events, or
 - 3) only meet events
- Time Trials begin promptly. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to be at the blocks, complete with her/his two timers (and two watches), and counter if needed, ready to swim.
- Timers must turn in their cards whether or not a swimmer achieves a desired cut time.

Order of Events

The 10 & Under 400 Free is a positive check-in event. All other 10 & Under events are Timed Finals with the fastest heat of each individual event swimming with Finals in the evenings. 11-12 events are Prelim/Final unless noted. The top 8 swimmers will qualify for Finals
