FACILITY: Eight 7 foot lanes, 25 yards, standard 12" deck level gutter system, pool

depth of 3 feet 6 inches at the non-starting end; non-turbulent Wave Eater II lane markers, backstroke flags, and 18 inch, above surface starting platforms at the deep end. Pool depth of 7'0" at the deep (starting) end. Please be advised that due to the depth of the non-starting end of the pool, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> leg of all 100-Yard/Meter relays will start in the water.

TIMING: Colorado System 5 electronic timing system with strobe/horn start touch

pads and manual backup timing buttons; manual timing with 2 watches per

lane

OFFICIAL RULES: Official 2008 USS Short Course and Wisconsin Swimming Rules shall

govern this meet. Swimmers must be registered WI USA Swimming

swimmers. Swimmers' age is as of June 1, 2008. No recall starts.

RELAYS: All relay events will be awarded ribbons for 1st - 4th place. Relays will **not** 

count toward individual high points trophies. Relay changes will be accepted at the sole discretion of the Meet Director, and all relay changes should be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the session in which the relay takes place. Changes are limited to swimmers already entered in other meet events. A 500 yard mixed gender Pineapple Relay will be offered at the end of the AM session. The relay will consist of seven swimmers (any ages and any combination of boy/girl). The relay will include seven legs in the following order and yardages: 25, 25, 50, 100,

150, 100, and 50 yards. The winning relay receives a pineapple.

WARM-UPS: Swimmers will use sit and slide entries except for entries in sprint lanes

during last 30 minutes of warm-ups. During the first 30 minutes of each warm-up session there will be circle swimming only, no diving from the starting blocks. The next 30 minutes: Lanes 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 will be open for sprints with diving from the blocks permitted. Lanes 1, 7 and 8 will be

for circle swimming.

**ENTRIES**:

Entries must be received by Wednesday, **May 21**<sup>st</sup>, **2008**, and should be submitted in HY-TEK COMMLINK format via email to sboruff@charter.net. Completed signed waiver, and fees must be received by Tuesday, **May 27**<sup>th</sup>, **2008**. Current USA-S ID number MUST be included. The cut-off for changes for individual events is May 27<sup>th</sup>. After that date, deck entry fees will apply. All deck entries must be able to prove USA-S membership.

**ENTRY LIMIT:** 

Individual entries will be accepted up to a maximum of 1600 entries for the meet. Entries not accepted will be notified by phone as soon as possible. SWIMMERS ARE LIMITED TO <u>FOUR (4)</u> INDIVIDUAL EVENTS AND TWO (2) RELAYS PLUS THE PINEAPPLE RELAY.

FINAL RESULTS:

A copy of the final results will be emailed to all participating clubs. Hardcopies may be ordered at \$5.00 per copy.

AWARDS:

Awards for relay events will consist of ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place, except for the Pineapple Relay that consists of a pineapple for 1<sup>st</sup> place only. Awards for individual events will consist of ribbons for 1st - 12<sup>th</sup> places by gender for each individual age 6&Under,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14 and 15&Over. Swimmers will be scored according to these individual age groups even though they may swim in events comprised of swimmers from more than one age group. Heat winner prizes will be awarded in all individual events (12 and under). Individual swimmers are requested to claim their own awards throughout the day. All awards **MUST** be picked up the day of the meet by individuals or coaches. Awards will not be mailed. Individual event high point trophies will be awarded by gender for 1st place for ages 6&Under, 7,8,9,10,11,12, 13, 14 and 15&Over. The high point trophies will be presented ASAP following the am meet to 11,12,13,14 and 15&Over year olds, and ASAP following the pm session to 6&Under, 7,8,9 and 10 year olds.

DECK SEEDING:

Deck seeding will be allowed at the sole discretion of the meet director to the extent that time and space are available but only to the limit of filling partially filled heats. No relay deck seeding accepted, but relay changes may be made. An \$8.00 charge per event will be assessed for deck seeding. Deck seeding will close at 8:00 AM for the AM Session and 30 minutes after the start of PM warm-ups for the PM Session. Coaches must be able to prove swimmer's USS membership. Results for deck seeding swimmers will be scored and count toward event and high point awards.

This is a PRE-SEEDED meet. IT IS THE SWIMMER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO BE AT THE BLOCKS AT THE START OF HIS/HER EVENT. Staging

SEEDING:

provided for 8 & Under swimmers.

POSITIVE CHECK-IN: Positive check-in will be required for the 500 freestyle. Swimmers not

checked in 15 minutes after the start of session warm-ups will be scratched from the event. This event may be limited to the top 40 swimmers (combined total for event) and will be run fast to slow. Positive check-in station will be located at the admissions table. Seeding for this event will be posted in the pool area and a copy given to each coach. Any swimmer unable to compete due to the limitation will be refunded the entry fee for this event or may deck enter for an event that has open lanes

(additional heats will not be added).

CONSOLIDATION: To expedite the meet and provide the best competition forum for

swimmers, within each session, the 500 freestyle event will be seeded and combined without regard to age or gender. Places, awards and published

results will be segregated by age group and gender.

ADMISSION: Admission is \$3.00 (10 and under free). Heat sheets will be sold for \$3.00.

Coach's packets will be available at the pool office. Coaches and Club Officials desiring to be on deck will be required to display proof of current

USS membership at all times.

CONCESSIONS: A selection of delicious hot and cold food and drinks will be available at

reasonable prices in the Waunakee High School Commons. Officials and coaches only need show their valid 2008 USA Registration card for

complementary food and beverages. No food allowed in pool area.

MEET CONDUCT: All teams are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers. The use of

recording devices (particularly camera phones with picture and video capability) is strictly prohibited in the locker rooms. The meet director and/or meet marshal, at his discretion, shall remove from competition and/or the aquatic center anyone behaving in a disruptive or disorderly

manner.
