QUALIFYING TIMES ACHIEVED AFTER FEBRUARY 25, 2002 Fax or email entries will be accepted for new qualifying times achieved between 11:59pm on Monday, February 25, 2002, and 1:00pm on Monday, March 4, 2002. Email entries to: <u>lfsc1@msn.com</u>; fax entries to (847) 735-6281. No entries will be accepted after the 1:00pm deadline. Confirmation of receipt of entry is the sole responsibility of the team or individual submitting the entry. Please call the LFSC office, (847) 735-5372, to confirm receipt of entry.

EVENT LIMITATIONS Swimmers may enter any number of events in which he/she has met the qualifying time standard; however, no swimmer may compete in more than five (5) individual events for the meet or more than three (3) individual events per day. Each team may enter no more than two relay entries per event.

SEEDING Entries shall be seeded according to USA Swimming rules. Entry times conforming to the course length for this championship meet (SCY) shall be considered "conforming times". All other times meeting the appropriate standard shall be considered "non-conforming times". The order of seeding for this meet is: short course yards (SCY), short course meters (SCM), long course meters (LCM). Please mark clearly ("SCM" or "LCM") to the right of the entry time.

CONDUCT OF THE MEET All events except the 1000 and 1650 freestyle and relay events will be conducted with preliminary and C, B, A (bonus, consolation, and championship) final heats. The 1000 free, 1650 free, and all relays are timed final events requiring a positive check-in.

- ∠ 1000 Free The 1000 free will be swum slowest to fastest alternating women and men.
- I650 Free The fastest seeded heat of the women's and men's 1650 free will be swum at the beginning of finals. All other heats of the 1650 free are swum at the conclusion of the preliminary session alternating women and men from fastest to slowest.
- Relays All relay events will be conducted as timed final events. The fastest two seeded heats of the 400 free relay (Friday) and the 400 medley relay (Sunday) will swim in the finals session. The single fastest seeded heat of the 800 free relay (Saturday) will swim in the finals session. All remaining seeded heats will be swum at the end of the preliminary session, fastest to slowest alternating women and men. A swimmer need not be entered in an individual event to participate in relays.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES National Championship scratch rules and procedures will be in effect at this meet. Scratches for the finals shall be made with the Administrative Referee. Scratches from preliminary events shall be made using the scratch box at the clerk of course. The scratch deadline for preliminary events is as follows:

TEAM AWARDS The top 10 teams in the combined scoring, and the top 5 teams in women's and men's scoring will receive awards.

INDIVIDUAL and RELAY AWARDS Medals for 1st - 8th places will be awarded for individual events; 1st - 3rd places will be awarded in relay events. High Point awards will be presented to the male and female swimmer scoring the most points in individual events.

AWARDS CEREMONY and READY ROOM Swimmers competing in C, B, or A final events are asked to report to the ready room area 15 minutes prior to their event. Awards for women and men will be presented after every 4th event. Relay awards for day one and day two events will be presented at the beginning of the following evening's finals.

TIME SCHEDULE Estimated event start times provided in the meet program are for information only and are not to be considered as an official time line.

FINES Any swimmer failing to achieve the qualifying time standard for any individual event must submit appropriate proof of having previously achieved the entry time standard. Any swimmer unable to provide such proof of performance shall pay a fine of \$25 to the host club. All such fines shall be paid prior to the swimmer participating in any further individual or relay events. Proof of performance must be in USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. Each club or individual is responsible for providing their own proof of performance.

WARM UP PROCEDURE General warm-up with circle swimming will take place in lanes 1-8 from the start of the warmup period to 45 minutes prior to the start of the meet. At 45 minutes prior to the start of the meet, 2 lanes will be designated push pace and 2-4 lanes will be designated for one way sprints.

USA SWIMMING MEMBERSHIP All swimmers must be current (2002) members of USA Swimming. All coaches and officials must be USA Swimming members. Any team or individual entering a swimmer without a current USA Swimming membership shall be subject to a fine of \$100.00 per event per swimmer.

DECK ADMITTANCE All swimmers, coaches, and officials will be issued deck credentials. These must be shown for admission to the pool deck. Please use designated pool entry areas.

REGISTRATION and CREDENTIALS Coaches packets and credentials will be available in the entrance area or at the Clerk of Course.

MEET COMMITTEE A meet committee consisting of at least one official, one coach, and one athlete will be appointed to decide protests arising from administrative matters. Written protests involving technical rules, except disqualification due to judgment decisions of the deck officials, shall be made to the meet referee within 30 minutes of the protested act or occurrence.

TIME TRIALS Time trials will be offered 15 minutes after the completion of the each preliminary session and after the 1000 freestyle, time permitting. Swimmers may enter no more than 3 individual events each day including time trials. The entry fee is \$7.50 individual events and \$15.00 relays. *Checks should be made payable to LFSC.* The time trial schedule is as follows:
