FACILITIES: Indoor 25 meter guttered pool 3 ft. 6 in. at its shallow end, 12 ft. at the deepest end, and 9 ft. at the starting blocks. The pool has six 7-ft. lanes, non-turbulent lane markers, backstroke flags, and slanted 18-in. starting blocks. Ample automobile parking outside and seating inside the pool area.

TIMING AND JUDGING: All events will be timed finals. Colorado timer and touch pads with horn start (button and manual timing backup with two timers per lane).

OFFICIAL RULES: Current USS 2000 and Wisconsin Swimming rules shall govern the conduct of this meet.

MEET SCHEDULE: 9:30 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. circle swimming only
10:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m. sprinting (one direction only, diving from blocks permitted) lane 3 and 4 only. Circle swimming in lanes 1, 2, 5, and 6.
10:35 a.m. - start of meet

Age groups are not divided into a.m. and p.m. time slots for this meet.

A short lunch break will be scheduled after the Coaches/swimmer relay. (20 minutes)

ENTRIES:

All swimmers must be USS registered. Please refer to the attached **List of Events** and submit entries on the enclosed forms. Please complete the **BOYS** and **GIRLS Swimmer Event** form listing each swimmer's name, USS number, age (as of November 11, 2000), and the events they will be swimming, as well as, the **Relay Teams Entry** form that will be used for computer entry and generation of the heat sheets. A signed **waiver** must also be submitted. Please submit your best estimated times for seeding purposes. Entries using **HY-TEK Meet Manager software are encouraged**. Please send disk along with hard copy. Meet Manager hard copies may be sent in lieu of enclosed forms. All entries must be submitted and mailed to the address shown below so that they arrive no later than **SATURDAY October 28, 2000.**

ENTRY LIMITS:

Only the first 350 relay team entries will be accepted. Entries not accepted will be notified by mail as soon as possible. **Swimmers are limited to five (5) relay entries.**

ENTRY FEES:

\$8.00 per relay event. Fees must accompany all entries. Please make checks payable to **McFarland Spartan Sharks**. Reservation monies will be refunded only if the meet is full.

CLERK OF COURSE:

There is no clerk of course for this meet. Relay cards for all age groups will be given to the coaches and the coaches are responsible for giving the cards to their swimmers and getting them to the blocks at the appropriate time. Heat sheets will be posted in various locations around the pool.

FINAL RESULTS: One copy of meet results will be sent to each team represented. All others wishing results can order them at the concession stand for \$2.00 per copy.

SCORING: The top three relay teams in each event will score points. Scoring will be 12-8-4.

AWARDS: Awards for the top three finishing relay teams in each event will consist of items such as towels, T-shirts, and other merchandise as purchased by the Sharks Swim Club or donated by Sharks families and area businesses.

ADMISSIONS: \$2.00 per person, which includes a heat sheet. No charge for children under 12 when accompanied by a parent.

CONCESSIONS: Delicious hot and cold food items will be available at reasonable prices.

CONDUCT: All teams are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers. The **Meet Director** may remove any swimmer from competition for disruptive or disorderly behavior.

NOTE: Some swimmers in events 1,2,7,8,39,40,41,42,43 and 44 will be entering the pool at the shallow end. (3 feet 6 inches).

NOTE: RELAY INSTRUCTIONS FOR KICK BOARD AND T-SHIRT RELAYS

KICK BOARD: Swimmers must have kick board in both hands at all times, except when touching the wall to finish their swim. Swimmers must also enter the water feet first.

T-SHIRT: Swimmers must have T-Shirt on before entering the water. (Backwards and/or inside-out is acceptable). Only relay members can help with the transfer of T-shirt from one swimmer to the next.
