The Competition Course has not been certified in accordance with USA Swimming's Rule 104.2.2(c). TIMING SYSTEM: A fully automatic timing system will be used with a manual backup button plus 2 backup timers for each lane. A horn start will be used to start all events. Should the automatic system fail, a backup starting device will be **ELIGIBILITY**: All swimmers must be currently registered with United States Swimming and their USA-S numbers must appear on the entry form. Out of state deck entrants must bring their USA-S cards and be prepared to show them to Clerk of Course. Age as of Friday, November 20th, 2009 will be used. Coaches must present a current coaching card before receiving packet. **ENTRY LIMITS:** All swimmers may enter a total of four (4) individual events plus relays each day of the meet. DECK ENTRIES/ Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the meet director, and REGISTRATION

must be accompanied by a payment of \$5 per individual event, \$15.00 per relay. Deck registration will be allowed if accompanied by a check for \$60.00 payable to Wisconsin Swimming, Inc.

FINAL RESULTS:

All teams will receive final results and they will be posted to the Wisconsin Swimming web site (http://wisconsinswimming.org) within one week of the completion of the meet. Any extra copies that may be required can be ordered at the admissions table for \$7.00.

OFFICIALS:

TIMING:

All events will be timed finals. Please submit correct YARD seed times.

ENTRY FORMS: This meet is computerized. **Do not submit entry cards.** The host club will

provide all relay cards. All team entries must be submitted using a Hytek Team Manager file. Unattached and individual swimmers may use the attached paper entry forms. SEEDING:

The meet will be pre-seeded except for: Friday events 5 - 6, 9 – 12, Saturday events 35 – 36, and Sunday events 93, 94, 125, and 126. These events will require positive check-in. The positive check-in events except for Friday events 5, 6, 9 and 10 will have at least the top 30 times swimming. The entries beyond the top 30 times will be allowed to swim if the timeline permits.
