TIMING SYSTEM: A fully automatic timing system will be used with a manual backup button plus 2 backup timers for each lane. A horn start will be used to start all events. Should the automatic system fail, a backup starting device will be used. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States Swimming **ELIGIBILITY:** and their USA-S numbers must appear on the entry form. Out of state deck entrants must bring their USA-S cards and be prepared to show them to Clerk of Course. Age as of Friday, November 19th, 2010 will be used. Coaches must present a current coaching card before receiving packet. **ENTRY LIMITS:** All swimmers may enter a total of four (4) individual events plus relays each day of the meet. **DECK ENTRIES/** Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the meet director, and REGISTRATION must be accompanied by a payment of \$5 per individual event, \$15.00 per relay. Deck registration will be allowed if accompanied by a check for \$60.00 payable to Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. FINAL RESULTS: All teams will receive final results and they will be posted to the Wisconsin Swimming web site (http://wisconsinswimming.org) within one week of the completion of the meet. OFFICIALS: Meet Referee Randy Shane. Head official is Kim Thompson from the Kenosha Barracuda Swim Team. **ENTRY FORMS:** 

This meet is computerized. **Do not submit entry cards.** The host club will provide all relay cards. All team entries must be submitted using a Hytek Team Manager file. Unattached and individual swimmers may use the attached paper entry forms. The sanctioned meet events can be downloaded from the Wisconsin Swimming website at: <a href="http://wisconsinswimming.org">http://wisconsinswimming.org</a>. The enclosed Recap of Entries Statement must be completed and the Waiver form signed. These must be returned together with the entry forms (Hytek file) and your check. Please submit the originals and save the copies for your records. In order to ensure accurate times and names, please PRINT clearly.

AWARDS:

Each class, A,BB,B-C, will receive medals for placement 1-3 and ribbons for placement 4-6 for 10 & under, 11-12, 13-14. For the events listed as 8 & Under, places 1-3 will receive medals and places 4-12 will receive ribbons. For all other events, age groups 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, and Seniors will receive medals for places 1-3 and ribbons for places 4-6. Relay ribbons will be awarded to places 1-3 for all age groups.

ADMISSIONS:

Admission charge for spectators will be \$3.00 per day for anyone 12 and over. Heat sheets will be available for \$3.00 per session. Friday night admission and heat sheet is \$3.00.

CONCESSIONS:

A concession stand will offer a wide selection of food and beverage options. Swim apparel will be available for sale.

CONDUCT:

All teams will be responsible for the conduct of their own swimmers. The meet marshals and meet director shall have the authority to disqualify swimmers for misconduct.

In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

SEEDING:

The meet will be pre-seeded except for: Friday events 5 - 6, 9 - 12 and Sunday events 95 - 96. The positive check-in events will have at least the top 30 times swimming. (The 1000 Free will be swum fastest to slowest seed time. The top 20 times for Senior Boys and Girls and the top 10 13-14 Boys and girls in each age group will be allowed to swim). (The 500 Free will be swum fastest to slowest seed time. The top 20 times for Senior Boys and Girls and the top 10 13-14 Boys and girls in each age group will be allowed to swim). If time allows heats will be added by fastest times regardless of age. No swimmers entered with a NT (no time) will be allowed to swim unless all NT entries can be accommodated within the timeline.
