Age Group Coach of the Year:				
<u>KEVIN BOOSKEYDC</u>	Kevin coaches the 10+U age group at YDC. The 10+U girls won age group high point at 12+U state. YDC boys 10+U team also took 3^{rd} place. Kevin coaches Hannah Aegerter, who won all 7 of her events and won 10+U girls' high point. Hannah also set state records in the 100 and 200 free and was part of the YDC 200 Free Relay that also set the state record. Kevin has done an outstanding job at YDC in the last 3 seasons and helped build the team to a 2^{nd} place finish at 12+U state in 2012.			
<u>DAVE WILLOUGHBY - SWAT</u>	Dave's kids always swim fast when it matters most, at state. They are continually improving and Dave's enthusiasm is a huge reason. They also swim technically very sound. SWAT Age group results: 3^{rd} 12+u Overall/ 4^{th} 10+U Boys/ 1^{st} 11-12 Girls/ 2^{nd} 11-12 Boys/ 5^{th} 13-14 Girls. Dave enthusiastically coaches all SWAT swimmers.			
JACOB JOHNSON –BAC	Consistently develops young swimmers. Team SC State Champions 2012.			
<u>SHANE RYAN -YDC</u>	Shane has done an outstanding job with his age groupers at YDC in a very short amount of time. In 2011, his 12+U swimmer set state records and both of his swimmers were named male and female age group swimmers of the year. This spring his 12+U placed 2 nd in a tight race for combined team score in division 1. Last year at the same meet his team scored 1027 points. This year they scored 1639 points, a significant improvement. His team also broke a state relay record. Shane continues to produce fast swimmers and score more points at state every year, both which I hold in high regard for Coach of the Year.			
<u>BOB JENKYNS—LAKE</u>	I am nominating Bob Jenkyns for coach of the year. I have worked alongside Bob for the past six years. He is dedicated to his swimmers, parents, and is a mentor to his age group staff. He is always looking for ways to better educate himself in leadership, coaching, and swim skills and shares and passes his knowledge to his staff, swimmers, and parents. His age group team scored 1088 points at state for a 4 th place finish. LCST's age group team is consistently near the top year after year after year. He is the coach of record for state champions Holly Stoll, Jasmine Hellmer, Leah Reisker, and Tyler Wrasman. Bob also served on the zone staff that won zones last summer. I think it's time for Bob to win this well-deserved award for his long time dedication to swimming in Wisconsin.

<u>HANNAH AEGERTER—YDC</u>	Won 10+U girl's high point award. Won all 7 individual events and both relays. Set state records in 100 and 200 free. Part of state record setting 200 free relay. Perfect 140 point score at state
<u>NATALIE CLAUSEN –WEST</u>	Broke 13-14 girl's state record in 1650 with a time of 16:40.24. Finished 9 th in 1650 at NCSA junior national meet. Developing into one of Wisconsin's best distance swimmers. State Meet places: 1650 (1 st) 500 Free and 400 IM (2 nd) 200 Free and 200 IM (3 rd), 200 Back (4 th)
<u>DOROTHY HALMY –WEST</u>	Dorothy had a tremendous performance at the NCSA JR National Championships this March in Orlando FL. The meet was swum prelims SCY and finals LCM. In the prelims of the 200 yd. free she went 1:50.99 and then came back in finals and went 2:05.52 LCM breaking the state record by .3. She swam to a 4:54.53 in the 500 yard free in prelims and then went 4:22.20 in the 400 m free breaking a 30 year old state record by 4 seconds. She narrowly missed the state record in the 800 m freestyle with a time of 9:01.96 and was just off the state record in the 1650 freestyle with a time of 16:46.30 and the 200 yard butterfly with a 2:03.72
<u>KATIE DRABOT—OZ</u>	No swimmer in Wisconsin has improved as much as she has. 13-14 girl high point winner/ 6 time state champion State records 200 Breast/ 200 IM/ 400 IM/ 200 and 400 Medley Relays
BEATA NELSON—YDC	Tied for 13-14 high point finisher at state. State records in 100 back, 200 back, and 100 fly as 13 year old.
<u>HOLLY STOLL—LAKE</u>	Holly had a perfect state meet including relays. She won each of her individual events and played an important role on all of LCST's winning 11-12 relays. She is also a great teammate and dedicated, hardworking swimmer at every practice.

Senior MALE Swimmer of the year

JONATHAN MARSH – VAC OUTSTANDING NATIONALLY RANKED BUTTERFLIER.

AS A 15 YEAR OLD AT THE 13+O STATE MEET JON BROKE TWO 15-16 BOYS STATE RECORDS (200 FLY 1:49.22 AND 500 FREE 4:29.54) AND WAS 2ND IN THE HIGH POINT RANKINGS FOR 15-16 BOYS. JON'S NATIONAL TOP TEN RANKINGS FOR 15 YEAR OLD BOYS AS OF 4/9: 200 FLY (2ND), 500 FREE (5TH), 200 FREE (1:39.49—4TH).

Senior FEMALE Swimmer of the year

BRIDGETTE ALEXANDER—J-HAWK BRIDGETTE, AGE 15, WON THE 15-16 HIGHPOINT AWARD AT THE MARCH STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS. HER SWIMS INCLUDED WINS IN THE 100 BACK (54.79), 200 BACK (1:58.56), AND 200 IM (2:05.05). SHE WAS ALOS 3RD IN THE 100 FLY (57.34) AND 100 BREAST (1:04.90). AT STATE BRIDGETTE SET A NEW 15-16 STATE RECORD IN THE 100 BACK, WITH HER TIME OF 54.79, DROPPING FROM A 56.27. IN DECEMBER BRIDGETTE QUALIFIED FOR THE OLYMPIC TRIALS IN THE 100 METER BACK AND JUST QUALIFIED HER 200 METER BACK AT THE MARCH NCSA MEET, WITH A NEW 15-16 STATE RECORD TIME OF 2:16.97. AT THE NCSA JUNIOPR NATIONAL MEET SHE ALSO FINISHED 8TH IN THE 100 METER BACK AND 11TH IN THE 50 METER BACK.
