FACILITY:	Eight 7-foot lanes, 25 yard pool with non-turbulent lane dividers and backstroke flags, recessed deck, 30-inch high fixed starting blocks, 4'9" to 5' pool depth at the staring end. Non-starting end of the pool is 4'. Balcony seating for 320 spectators. <u>This competition course has not been certified in accordance with USA Swimming's Rule 104.2.2C(4).</u> All events will start at the starting end, including 8 & Under events.
TIMING:	Colorado electric timing system with touch pads and manual back- up buttons and horn start. Each lane has two timers with electronic stopwatches.

RULES:	Official USA-S Rules shall prevail for this meet. Age is as of January 14, 2012.
TIME:	Warm ups to start at 7:00am-8:00am both days. The meet starts at 8:05am. The PM warm ups start immediately following the end of the AM Session (but not before 11am) and will last 45 minutes. General warm-ups/circle swimming will be in all lanes for each warm-up session. Push-pace and sprint lines will be opened and closed as necessary by the Meet Director and Meet Marshals. Sit and slide or 3 point entry will be enforced during general warm-ups
OFFICIALS:	Meet Referee: Scott Krueger Additional officials: Chad Behling; Officials from other teams are welcome and should contact Chad Behling to volunteer. (behling4@scbglobal.net)
SEEDING:	This is a pre-seeded meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to be at the blocks at the start of his/her events. <b>All 8 &amp; under events</b> <b>will be staged.</b> Please have all your 8 & Under swimmers report to the designated staging area for their events. <b>Positive check in required of all 400 IM's, 500 Frees and 1000's</b> <b>Free events.</b>
ENTRIES	Individuals may enter 4 individual events on Saturday plus relays, and 4 individual events on Sunday, plus relays. A team may enter an unlimited number of relays in any relay events. Ages are as of January 14, 2012. <u>Swimmers with special needs should be noted</u> on your entry form. Your coach is responsible for notifying the head official during warm-ups of any special needs of your swimmers.
	Deck registrations will not be accepted. Deck entries may be accepted to fill open lanes in existing heats only at \$5.00 per individual event and \$14.00 per relay. Deck Entries will close 30 minutes prior to the beginning of each session. Plus \$2.00 splash fee, if necessary. No deck entries will be accepted without a current USA Swimming registration being shown to the meet director.
ENTRIES & DEADLINE	<b>Meet entries due by December 30, 2011.</b> Signed waiver/paperwork and payment due by Janurary 3, 2012. No phone entries will be accepted. All entries must be accompanied with a check covering all team entries. Entries must be sent via Hy- tek Team manager provided that the Team Manager Event #'s associate with the Meet manager event #'s and a hard copy of the Team manager entry is included. Name the meet in Team Manager "FSC JANUARY 2012". Please check that all swimmers have USA-S memberships and are submitted to the LSC registration chair before the entry deadline.
ENTRY FEES:	\$4.00 per individual events, \$12.00 per relay, splash fee of \$2.00 per Individual.

ADMISSIONS:	\$3.00 per spectator over 12 years of age. Heat sheet \$3.00 per session.
AWARDS:	Medals 1 <sup>st</sup> -3 <sup>rd,</sup> Ribbons 4 <sup>st</sup> -12 <sup>th</sup> place. Relays will be awarded 1 <sup>st</sup> -6 <sup>th</sup> place ribbons. Heat Awards will in all <u>8 &amp; Under Events</u> High Point Awards: Trophies 1 <sup>st</sup> -3 <sup>rd</sup> place, Medals 4 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> place. High Point Awards will be awarded to those swimmers who <b>legally</b> complete <u>ALL REQURIED IMX EVENTS</u> for their age group (10 & U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-18). Swimmers that <u>deck seed</u> into an IMX event or are designated to Sheri Dowidat by the entry deadline will not be eligible for a High Point Award. High Point Awards will be calculated using the standard 16 place scoring method. Points from non-IMX events will not count toward the High Point Award. No Team High Point Trophies are being awarded.
FINAL RESULTS:	One copy of the meet's results will be sent to each team. A meet back-up will be posted at <u>www.wisconsinswimming.org</u> The swimmers IMX Score / Ranking can be obtained on the USA Swimming website after the final results of this meet have been posted /submitted to SWIMS.
FOOD:	Concessions will be provided throughout the meet.
CONDUCT:	Each team is responsible for the behavior of their swimmers. The meet director or meet marshal may remove any swimmers from the competition for disruptive or disorderly behavior. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited. Any swimmer entered in the meet be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start each race from within the water, When unaccompanied by a member- coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement

#### Age Groups and Events

The following single age groups and event combinations are used by USA Swimming in tabulating and scoring a swimmer's IMX ranking:

10 & Under:

200 IM, 200 Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast, 100 Fly

<u>11-12 year old:</u> 200 IM, 500 Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast, 100 Fly

<u>13 – 14; 15 – 18 year old:</u> 200 IM, 400 IM, 500 Free, 200 Back, 200 Breast, 200 Fly
