Date: October 23, 2010

- Location: Waterloo High School 651 Monroe Street Waterloo, WI 53594
- Classification: A-BB-B+C classification will be used for 10&U, 11-12, and 13-14 age group swimmers. The 8&U and Senior/Open swimmers will be A-B-C combined. All classes will swim together according to age and sex. All relay events will be A-B-C combined.
- Facility: Six (6) lanes, 25-yard pool with non-turbulent lane markers, backstroke flags, and 28" blocks. Pool depth is 3.5 ft. at its shallow end and 10 ft. at the starting block end. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and the 4<sup>th</sup> leg of the 100 yard relays will be required to start in the water. Ample parking available in the high school parking lot and seating in the pool area. The Competition Course has not been certified in accordance with USA Swimming's Rule 104.2.2C(4).

Timing

- System: Colorado electric timing system with touch pads and manual back-up buttons and horn start. Each lane will have two timers with electronic stop watches.
- Meet Time Schedule: AM Session: Warm ups 7:30 - 8:30 AM

Meet Begins: 8:40 AM

- Warm Ups: The first half hour of warm up session will be circle swim only in all lanes. The last half hour, lanes 1,2, and 3 will be for one way sprints, diving from the block permitted. Feet first three-point entries from the starting end of the pool during general warm-ups will be enforced for all sanctioned/approved competition.

- Eligibility: All teams must hold current 2010-2011 USA Swimming memberships. All swimmers must also have a current 2010-2011 USA Swimming registration. Swimmers age as of October 23, 2010 shall determine age group eligibility. All out of state swimmers must register with the Meet Director prior to entering the water: a valid USA Swimming membership card must be presented. Coaches acting in a coaching capacity must have passed the required certification tests and must display the current membership card.
- Rules: Current Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. and USA Swimming rules will govern this meet. This is a short course meet.

- Entries: Only the first 900 entries will be accepted. Entries not accepted will be notified by phone and reservation money will be refunded. Swimmers may compete in up to four (4) individual events plus two (2) relays. This will be a pre-seeded meet. All swimmers are expected to be at the blocks, ready to swim, when their events and heats are announced. Deck entries will be permitted in unfilled heats only, and at the discretion of the Meet Director. Deck seeding will close at 8:00 AM for the morning session and 11:30 AM for the afternoon session. Please indicate on the entries form any special needs for those athletes requiring assistance. Also, please inform the head official of those needs prior to the start of the meet.
- Deadline: Send completed waiver, entry forms, and entry fees to the Meet Director no later than October 11, 2010. Late entries will not be accepted after the Tuesday before the meet except for deck seeding the day of the meet. The meet will be run using Hy-Tek Manager. Meet entries on disc or e-mail using Hytek Meet Manager is highly encouraged. Scoring will be computerized.
- Fees: Entry fees are \$4.00 for individual events (\$5.00 for deck seed), \$12.00 for relays (\$15.00 for deck seed), and a \$3.00 splash fee per swimmer. Entry fees must accompany entry forms. Make checks payable to: Waterloo Swim Club. Fees are non-refundable.
- Admission: Admission is \$3.00 for adults. There is no admission fee for students. Heat sheets are \$2.00. Coach's packets will be available at the admission table. Coaches and club officials desiring to be on deck will be required to display proof of current USA Swimming membership at all times.
- Awards: Individual events: 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Ribbons for 10&U, 11-12, 13-14; 1<sup>st</sup>-8th<sup>h</sup> Ribbons for 8&U and Senior/Open. Relays 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>th</sup> Ribbons. Awards will be given for both classes of swimmers A-BB-B and C. Achiever awards will be given to any C swimmer achieving a B time or better in the 10&U, 11-12, and 13-14 age groups.
- Concessions: Food and beverages will be available at reasonable prices in the pool lobby.
- Meet Results: Each team will be mailed one copy of the meet results. Additional copies will be available for \$5.00 per copy and may be purchased by contacting the Meet Director.
- Conduct: It is expected that each club will be responsible for the conduct of their swimmers in all areas of the high school. A rest area will be provided in the high school gymnasium for the swimmers. If in the opinion of the meet marshals and/or Meet Director, a swimmer's conduct is harmful to others or property, they will be asked to leave the meet. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited.
   Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
