The Walter Schroeder Aquatic Center is an indoor 50-meter pool with two bulkheads, 16 starting blocks, 6-1/2' - 17' depth. Colorado Timing equipment will be used. The competition courses have been certified in accordance with USA Swimming's rule 104.2.2(c) the copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

For 13-14 & Senior Age Groups = 400 I.M (#9,10,11,12) & 400 Freestyle (#33,34,35,36)
These individual events will be conducted as Timed Finals and will require POSTIVE CHECK-IN by 7:30am on Saturday June 19th. The top 8 checked-in competitors will swim during the evening FINALS SESSION, with the remaining heats being swum during the AM prelims. **THE TOTAL NUMBER OF HEATS TO BE SWUM FOR THESE EVENTS MAY BE LIMITED at the discretion of the meet host.** The TOTAL NUMBER OF HEATS to be swum will be announced and distributed with the preliminary meet timeline on or before Wednesday June 16th.

For 11-12 & 10 & Under Age Groups = 10 & Under 200 Free (#61 & 62) & the 11-12 400 Free (#63 & 64) will be pre-seeded, Timed Finals events and will be swum to completion during the afternoon prelims session. **THE TOTAL NUMBER OF HEATS TO BE SWUM FOR THESE EVENTS MAY BE LIMITED at the discretion of the meet host.** The TOTAL NUMBER OF HEATS to be swum will be announced and distributed with the preliminary meet timeline on or before Wednesday June 16th.

The Referees and the Meet Director may choose to combine heats, fill empty lanes or move heats to improve the conduct of the meet.

Swimmers must complete a positive check-in with the Clerk of Course to swim these events by 7:30 a.m. on June 19th:

ALL 400 Freestyle and 400 Meter I.M. events for the 13-14 and Senior age groups. (This includes events #9,10,11,12,33,34,35,36)

AWARDS:

12 & Under Events: Medals 1st-3rd & Ribbons 4th - 8th for all Individual events
Ribbons 1st - 3rd for all Relay events
13 & Over Events: Ribbons 1st - 8th for individual events ONLY.

ELIGIBILITY:

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming and their USA Swimming numbers included on the entry. Age is as of Saturday June 19th, 2010. Swimmers with a disability are welcome and should contact David Joyce for any accommodation or entry time waiver they need.

ENTRIES:

Total individual event entries for the meet will be limited to 1500.

ENTRY LIMIT:

Athletes may enter a maximum of three individual events plus relays
