Proposed by Age Group and Senior Committee At its Meeting on March 28, 2012, the Rules Committee recommended the following changes:

12.2 Distribution of Travel Funds—Swimmer Reimbursement

12.2.1 Not later than October 1st, a list of Qualifying Meets for swimmer reimbursement will be published by the Technical Planning Chair on the Wisconsin Swimming website each year, for the upcoming Short Course and Long Course seasons. Reimbursement for these Meets will be obtained from the Wisconsin Swimming's Travel Fund.

Qualifying Meets: The LSC will reimburse an athlete who competes in a Meet
identified below, between September 1st and August 31st, according to the
following schedule. Relay only athletes will be reimbursed at one half the level
share:

A. Level 1 (1share)	One Spring Speedo Championship Series, One Summer
	Speedo Championship Series, One Zone C
B. Level 2 (4 Shares)	NCSA Spring Junior Championship
C. Level 3 (7 Shares)	Long Course Junior Nationals, Paralympic Open
	(Winter)
D. Level 4 (11 Shares)	Short Nationals, Long Course Nationals, Paralymics
	Nationals (Summer)
E. Level 5 (14 Shares)	Olympic Trials

- 12.2.2 National Junior Team travel will be reimbursed based on USA Swimming's

 Recommendation. NCSA Junior Team will be reimbursed two hundred fifty

 dollars (\$250) upon written receipt of their written Meet Report. These funds will
 be obtained from the Wisconsin Swimming's General Fund
- 12.3.4 Request for Any Exception: A swimmer requesting an exception to the Travel Fund disbursement policy must make the request to the LSC Review Committee Age Group/Senior Committee.

Rational:

The reimbursable Meets seem to change each year, so the publishing a Table of Qualifying Meets seems reasonable. The Age Group/Senior Committee seems most aware of likely meets eligible for consideration for reimbursement.
