Directions to Waukesha County Technical College, Pewaukee Campus

- **Coming from East on Hwy 190 (Capitol Drive):** Travel west on Hwy 190. Turn left onto Hwy 16. Take first exit, Main Street (Exit 188). Turn left off Hwy ramp. Proceed to WCTC main entrance on right.
- **Coming from East on I-94:** Travel west on I-94. Exit onto Hwy 16 West (exit 293C). Continue to first exit, Main Street (exit 188). Turn left off Hwy ramp. Proceed straight into the WCTC main entrance.
- **Coming from West on I-94:** Travel east on I-94. Exit Hwy T (exit 293). Turn left onto Hwy T. Follow Hwy T North about 2 miles to the WCTC main entrance on left.
- **Coming from the West on Hwy 16:** Travel east on Hwy 16. Exit Main Street (Exit 188). Turn left off hwy ramp. Proceed to the WCTC main entrance on right.
