The past 4 years the 12 and Under Meet has fallen on the weekend when Waukesha Schools are off school. Makes for a stress free, user friendly facility for spectators. Parking is PLENTIFUL and FREE!

OFFICIALS THAT WILL ENHANCE YOUR EVENT.

- Our team is committed to coming up with a theme for the meet and putting together a budget to decorate the facility to make the event an event for the spectators and swimmers. Use of the scoreboard for awards presentations for results and video of awards winners will be used. The scoreboard can also be used to show pictures of each event winner during the meet.
- 2) Ability to project underwater footage onto the scoreboard during the start and turn is available to provide a unique perspective for swimmers and spectators.
- Theater tape will be used to rope off an area to separate the officials work area and the swimmers and coaches areas. This helps to create a stress free environment not having to worry about officials and swimmers standing in the way of each other while the meet is running. Officials will have at least 5' of space with in which to officiate on all sides of the pool.
- 4) Seating at deck level provides a very loud and exciting atmosphere for the swimmers to compete in.
- 5) Option of running the meet in 8, 9, or 10 lanes depending on the number of entries/swimmers. Would allow us to fit this year's increase in participants in the facility without having to make any time standard adjustments as our current standards run through 2012.
- 6) Access to the Fieldhouse and or cafeteria for swimmer's resting areas (located adjacent to the pool only steps away).
