- 1) Theater tape will be used to rope off an area to separate the officials work area and the swimmers and coaches areas. This helps to create a stress free environment not having to worry about officials and swimmers standing in the way of each other while the meet is running. Officials will have at least 5' of space with in which to officiate on all sides of the pool.
