Team 1) We rent the high school pool for \$500 in the summer (2 hours, 5 days a week), \$120 per semester for Fall and Winter (1.5 hours, 2 days a week), and we are charged \$10 for each out of district swimmer who uses the pool (usually about \$200 more per semester). The YMCA allows us 13 hours a week in the fall/winter and 5 hours a week in the summer to have full use of the pool.

Team 2) \$25 per hour for 8 hour per week during school year at local high school. \$25 per hour for 7 hours per week during the summer (outdoor pool).

Team 3) \$42 per hour for 16 lanes during winter and \$30 per hour during summer (local high school pool).

Team 4) We donate money to our YMCA for pool needs (examples: fins, kick boards, pool updates i.e., new floor for locker room, record board, etc.). The amount donated varies depending on how much extra money we have on hand.

Team 5) We donate what we can afford.

Team 6) Not charged any rent.

Team 7) \$20.50 per hour (credits for club running high school meets and equipment donations for local high school), \$30.00 per hour (10% discount if paid in advance local private school), \$5.00 per hour (local high school), and \$.50 per swimmer, per visit (local outdoor pool). Approximate annual total is \$8200.

Team 8) \$6000 per year (use of two local high schools). Money earmarked as a donation for local high school swim team to purchase needed equipment. \$40 per practice session (2.5 hours) at local college.
